Surveyed March 13 + 14th 1876, for John Glynn, the Town of Glynnwood situated on the West half of the S.W.^{1/4} of Sec. 20, T. 5 S., R. 5 E., where the E. & A. R. R. crosses the County road on the West line of said Section. Lots are 50 by 150 ft. except fractions. Alleys all 16 1/2 ft. wide. Streets all 50 ft. wide. Main St. has 30 ft. east of the Sec. line. Lots South of R. R. are 60 ft. from center of track leaving 10 feet between lots and R. R. Ground. Lots North of R. R. are 100 ft. from center of track and fronting on Depot ground.
