

Ordinance No 4.

Whereas on the 15th day of June A.D. 1877 a majority of the qualified voters of the Incorporated Village of St. Johns Auglaize County Ohio at a Special Election held for that purpose voted for a Surrender of the Corporate right and Franchises of Said Village, therefore Resolved by the Trustees of Said Village for Special purposes that Said rights and Franchises are hereby Surrendered and Said Village of St. Johns is hereby restored and reinstated in all the rights and privileges held the same prior to the incorporation thereof, done this 22nd day of June A.D. 1877.
