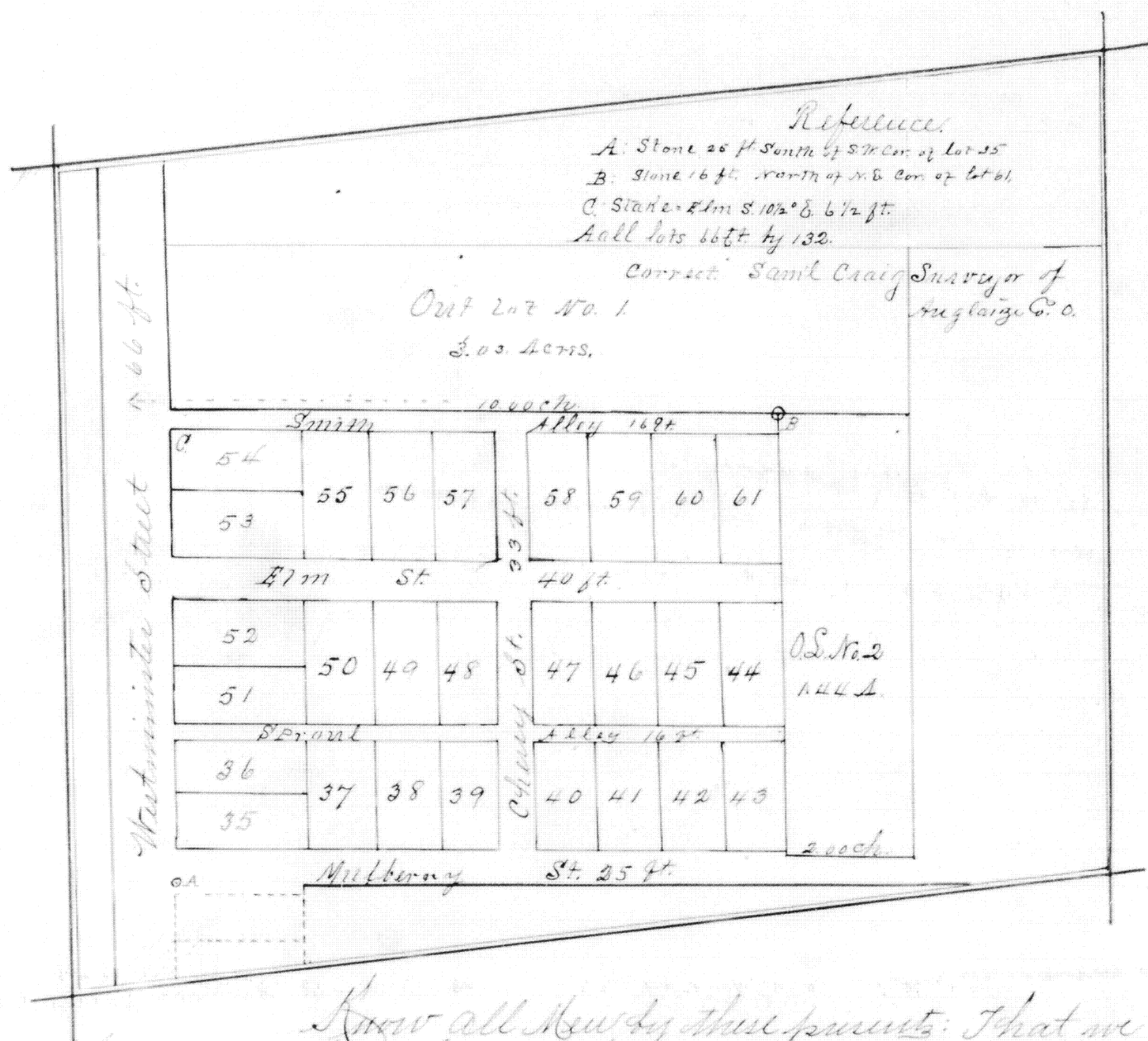


Sproul Bros. Addition to Waynesfield



Know all Men by these presents: That we Samuel P. Sproul and Adam T. Sproul, of Auglaize County, Ohio, do make public, and adopt the annexed plat A subdivision, made by Samuel Craig, surveyor, of the West part of the North half of the South half of the South West quarter of section seventeen, town five South, Range eight East, of which we are the proprietors; and dedicate to the use of the public forever as highways, the Streets and alleys therein indicated and named.
