

Know all Men by these presents, that we John and David A. Barrington of Auglaize County Ohio, do make public and adopt the aforesaid plat of Subdivision made by Samuel Craig Surveyor of Out Lot No. 61 of the town of St. Marys Auglaize County, Ohio, of which we are the proprietors and dedicate to the use of the public forever as highways, the Streets therein indicated and named.

I hereby certify that at a meeting of the council of the incorporated Village of St. Marys this held March 6th 1883, the following Resolution No. 5. was passed.

Resolution At. 5.

Whereas John and David Barrington did on the 3rd day of Jan'y 1883 dedicate to the public free as a highway Pine Street in this subdivision of Out Lot No. 61, in the town of St. Marys Auglaize County Ohio, as subdivided Dec. 29th 1882 by them as proprietors, Therefore the Council in regular session accepted said dedication and do hereby incorporate said street as a part of the highway or street in said village;
