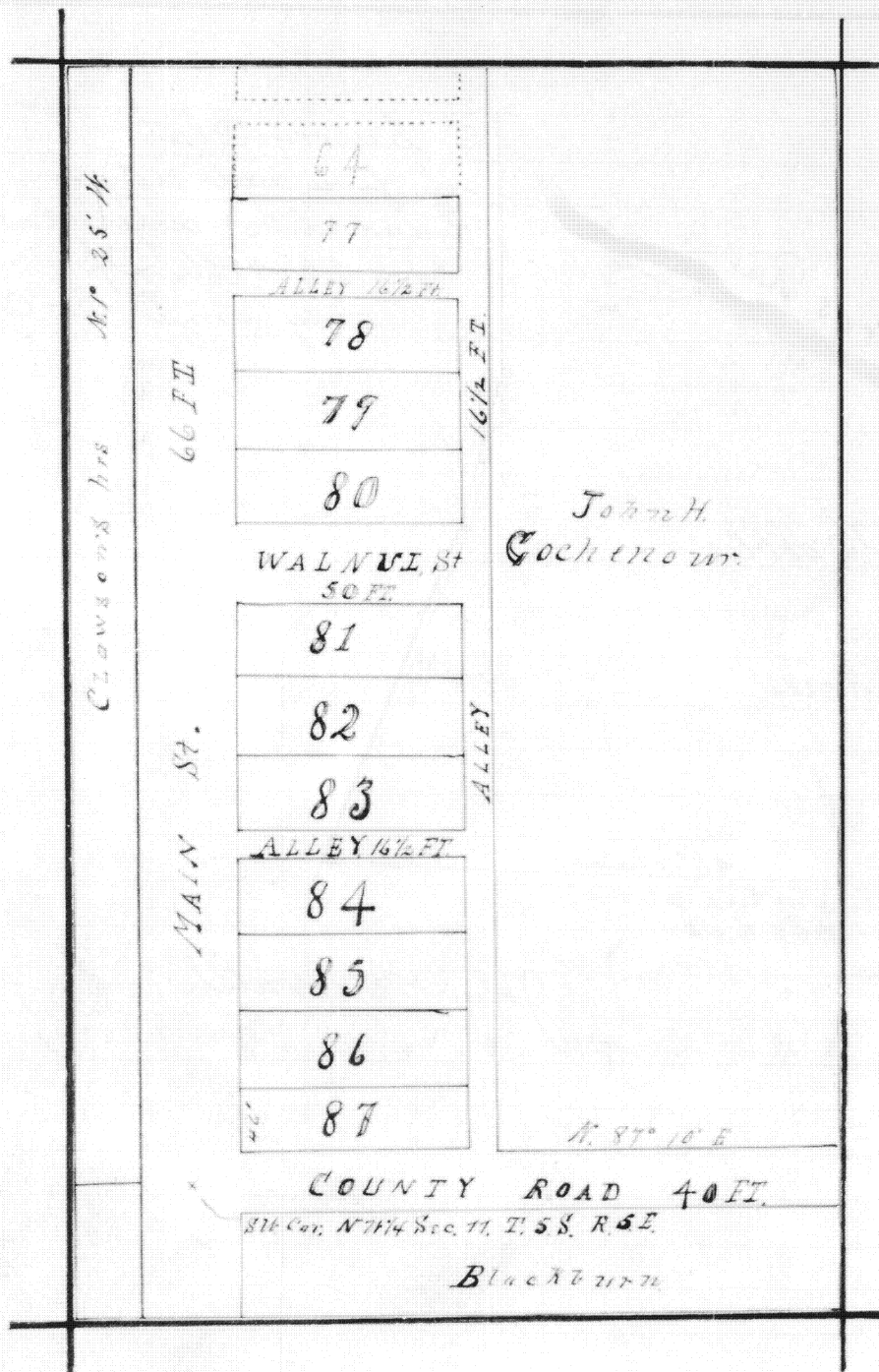


Gochenour's Third Addition to White Feather.
