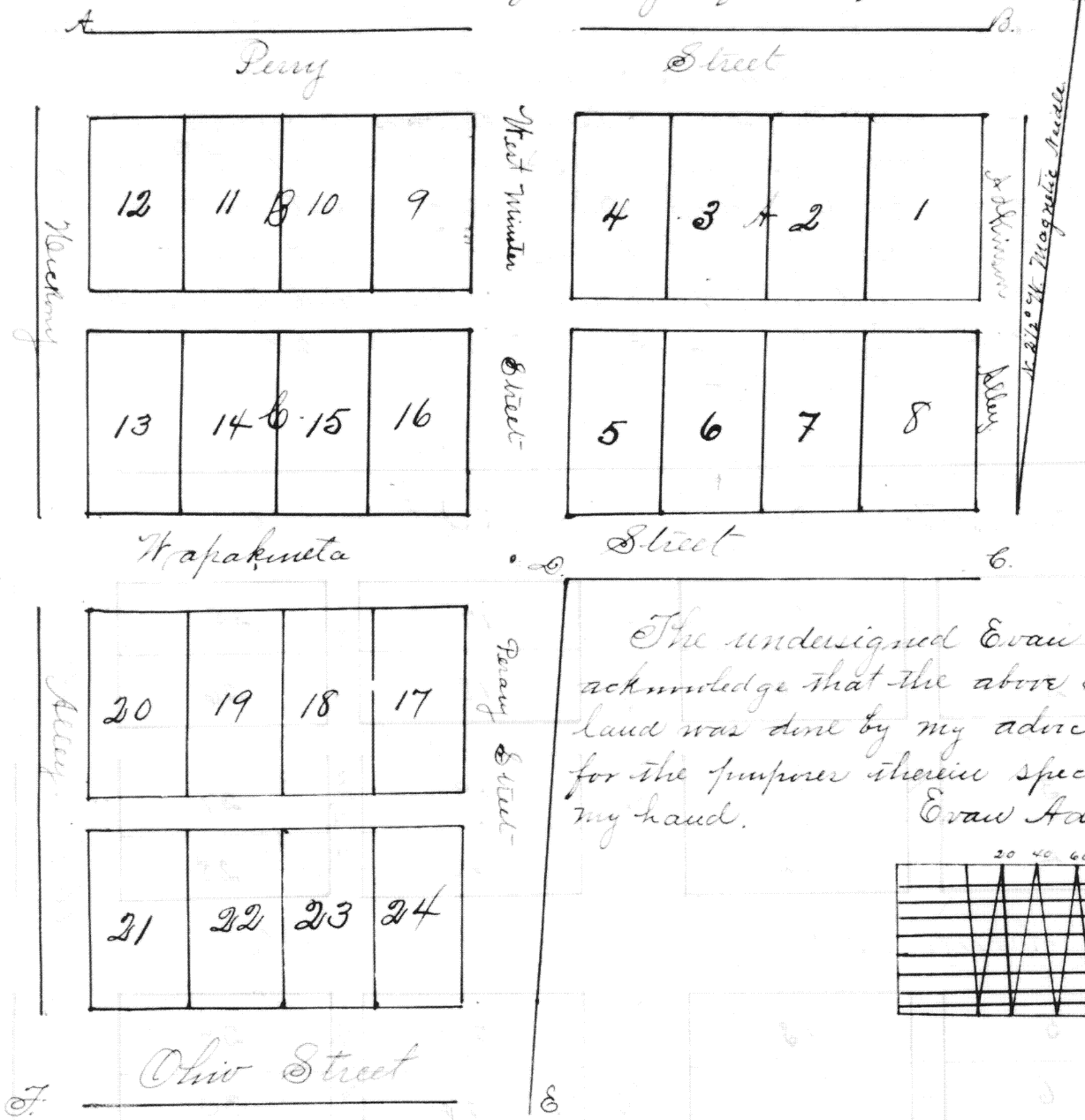


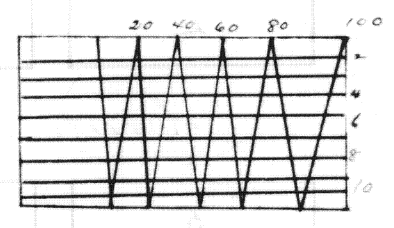
Wynnsfield

The New Town Plat of Wynnsfield, first Plat.



The undersigned Evan Adkinson, do acknowledge that the above Survey of my land was done by my advice and consent for the purposes therein specified as Witness my hand.

The New Town of Wynnsfield Auglaize County Ohio contained and laid out A. On the South West quarter of section 17, B. On the North East quarter of the North East quarter of section 18, C. South half of South East quarter of section 19, all of Township five (5) South of Range eight (8), East. The Kapaemita and West Minister Streets are 60 feet wide. The Perry and Ohio Streets are 4 1/2 feet wide. The Alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide, and all cross at right angles. The Lots are 66 feet wide in front and one hundred and thirty two feet deep. Stakes are planted on the corners, A. B. C. D. E. & F. commencing with letter A on the North West quarter of said town Lots, Survey thence East to B, thence South to C, thence West to D, (a stone is placed on the corner D.) thence South to E, thence West to F, thence North as certified to A begin. all of which is certified to be correct. July first 1848.
