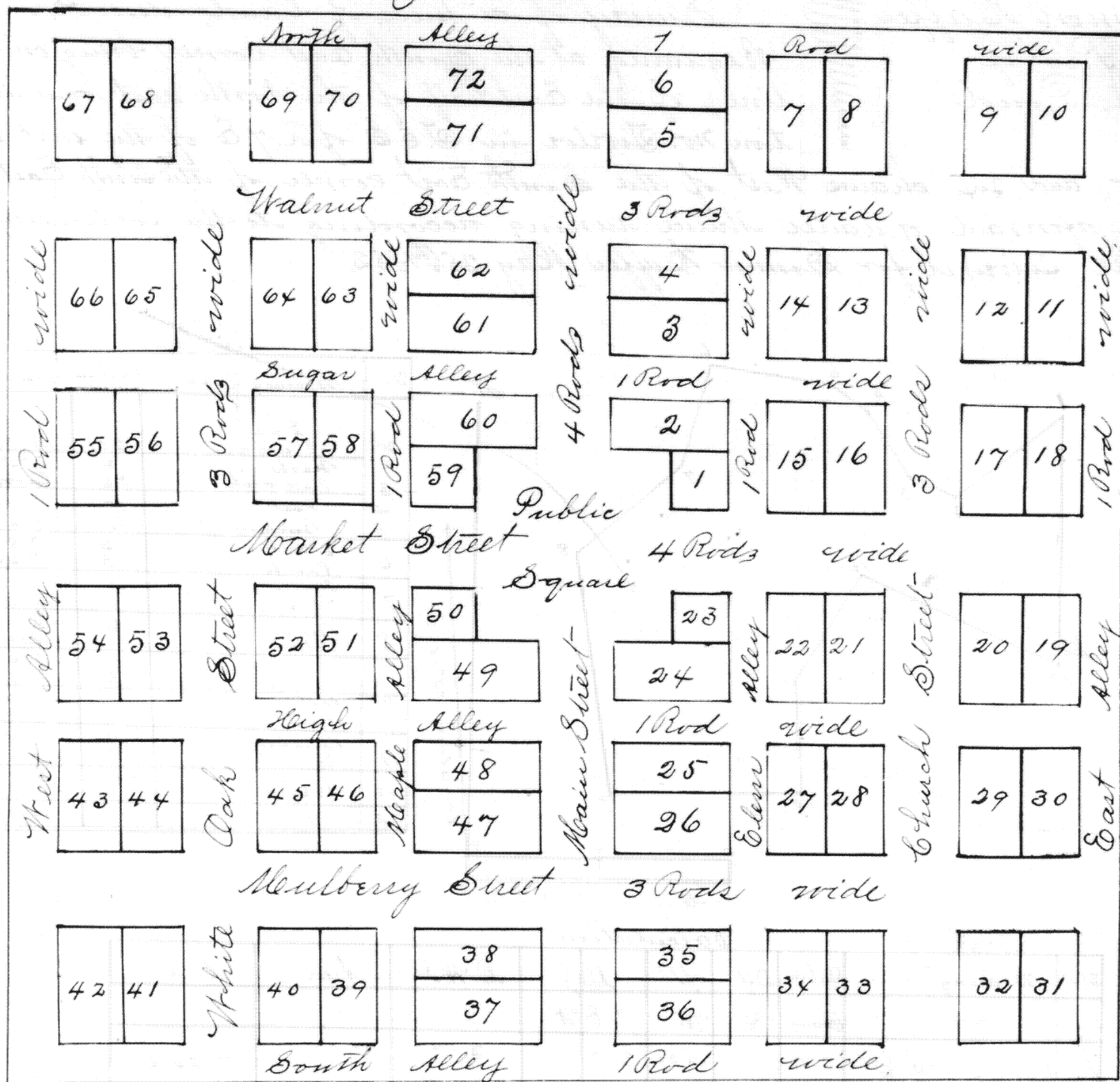


Janesville



The Town of Janesville is laid out on a piece of ground embracing the South East corner of section thirty six 36, Town 5 South of Range 6 East & the South West corner of Section thirty one, Town 5 South of Range seven east. Lots Nos. 1, 23, 50 and 59 are each four rods wide and six rods long, all the others are each four rods wide and eight rods long (S.R.S.) A Monument at the South west corner of Lot No. 1 The Streets and Alleys all cross each other at right angles, running with the Cardinal points of the Compass.
