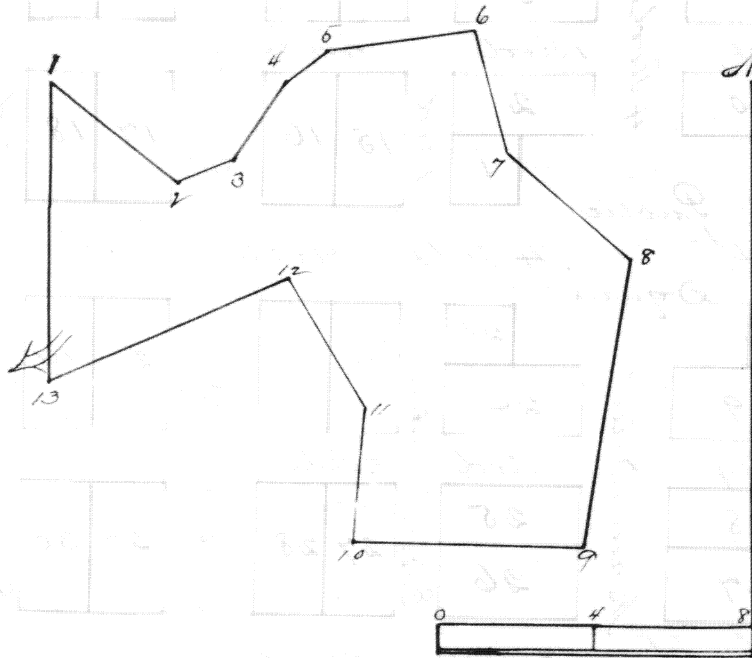


Simon Kuffer
