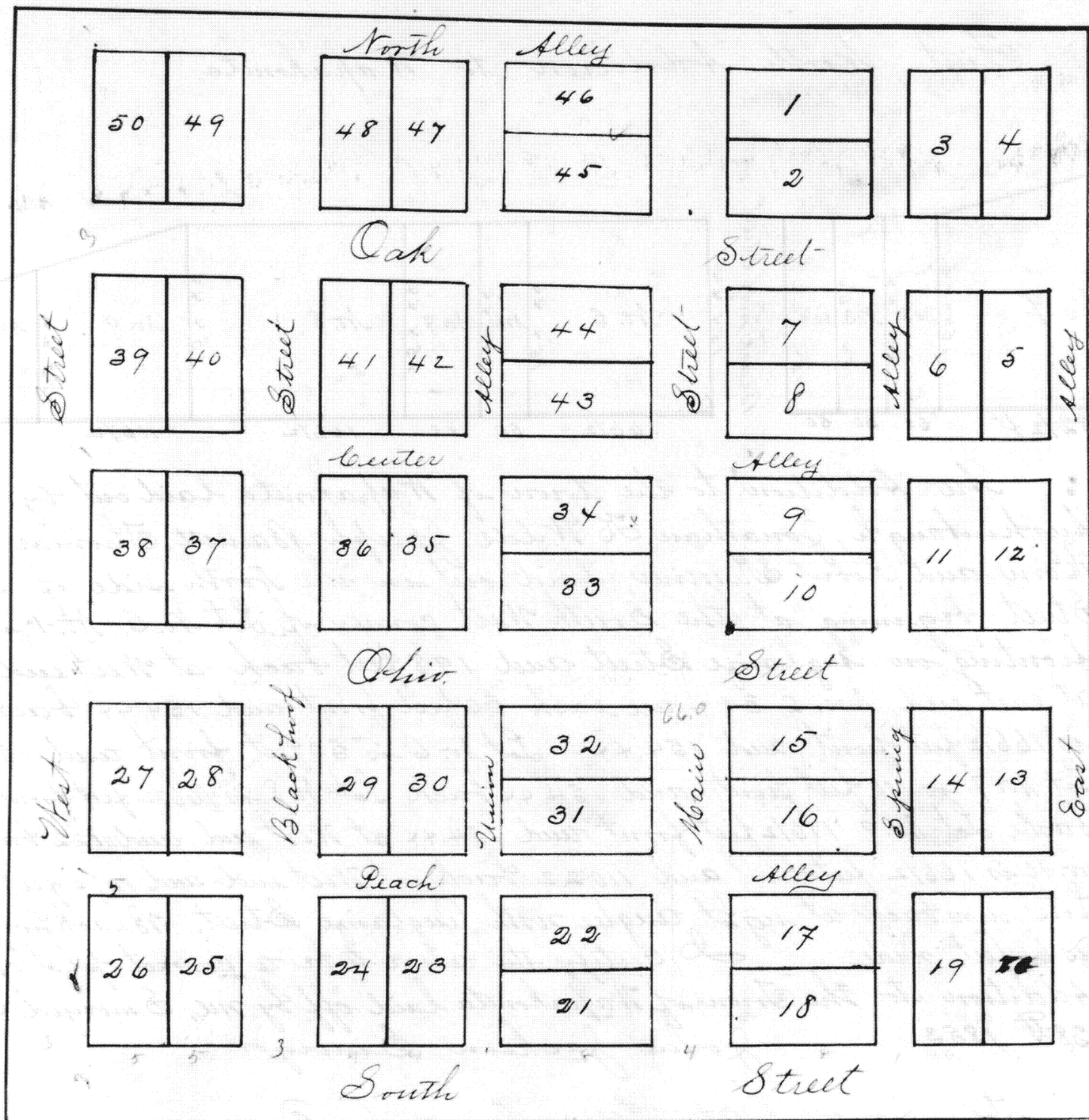


Uniopolis



The Town of Unionville is laid off on the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Sect. 17 Town 5 South Range 7 East. Lots Nos. 25, 26, 27, 28, 37, 38, 39, 40 & 49 & 50 are each 5 Rods wide and 8 Rods long, all the other lots are each 4 Rods front and 8 Rods back. The Streets and Alleys cross each other at right angles, Ohio and Main Streets are each 4 Rods wide, Blackhawk, Oak & South are 3 Rods wide & West Street is 43 feet wide. The Alleys are each one rod wide & a Monument is planted at the South West corner of Lot No. 10.
