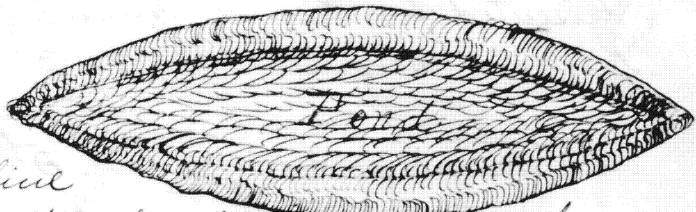
29 Twenty nine Town-

Ayers, All Lots are fifty
feet in front and one
hundred and fifty feet
back, except Lots 11, 15, 16,
43, 44, 45 & 46, Lot No. 13 on
north end 50 feet, South end
14 feet, No. 14 North end 50-
running to a point on east
side at ninety feet. No. 15 North
end 32 feet running to a point
on east line at forty six feet. Lot
16 North end 50 feet running to a
point on east line at 120 feet. No. 43,
50 feet on North end running to a point
on east end at 150 feet. Lot 44 on North
line 24 feet running to a point on east line
at 36 feet. Lot 45 North end 50 feet running to a point on east line at 111 feet
Lot No. 46 on North end 50 feet running to a point on east line at 150 feet.

All Streets are 66 feet wide and all Alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide, running at right
Angles. The Proprietor donates all Streets and Alleys for public Highways.
Monuments placed for future surveys are a stone at South west corner of Lot No. 20
and North east corner of Lot 32, and South West corner of 37. Attest M. Letherman S. & C.
