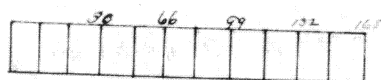
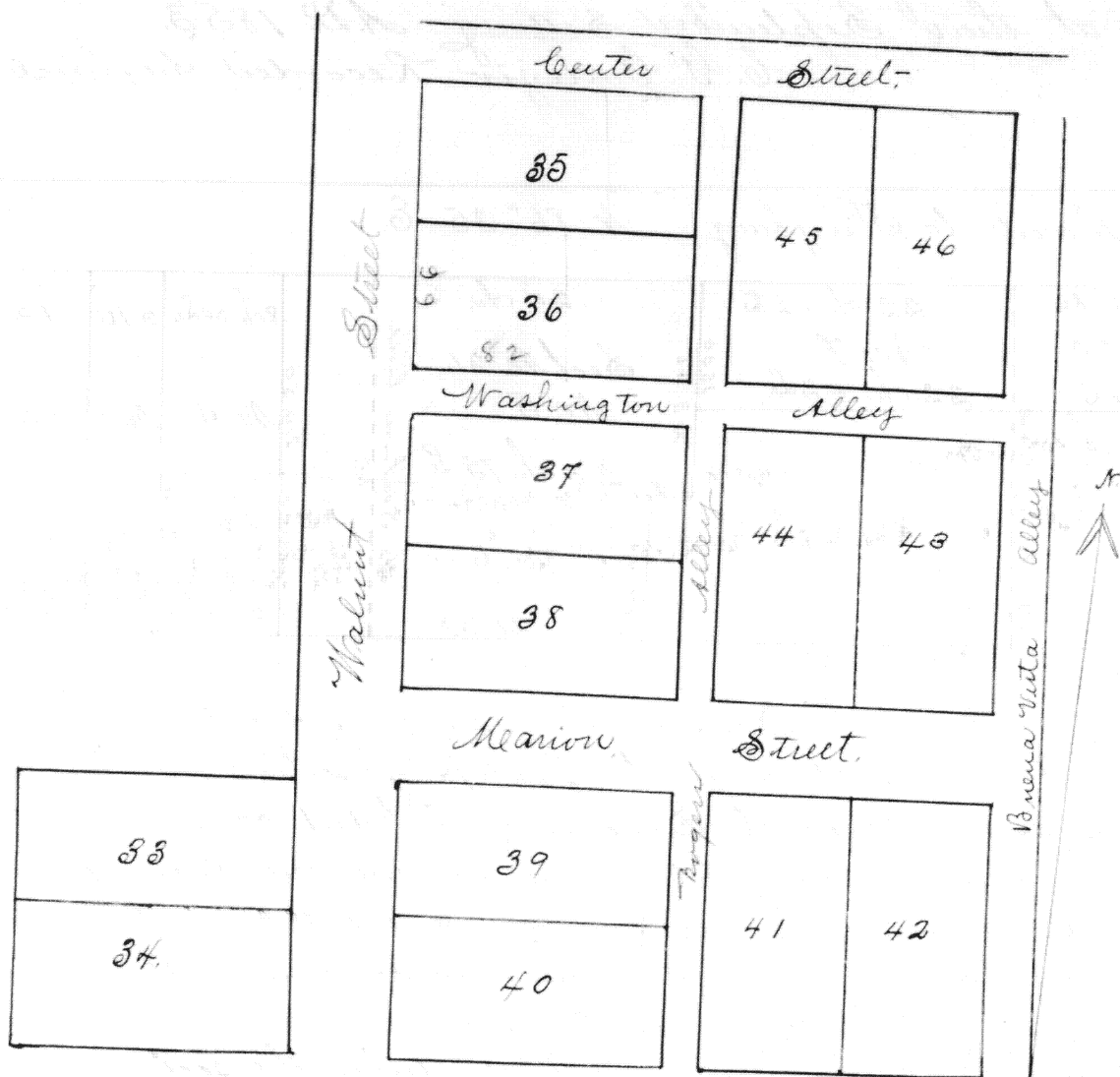


# St. John East Addition

Scale from 165 ft. The East Addition of the Town of St. John laid out on the North West quarter of Section No. 5. T. 6 S. R. 7 E. North and South Streets are  $2^{\circ} 35'$  to the East & West, Streets running  $86^{\circ}$ , it contains 14 Lots. All Lots are 60 feet in front & 132 feet back as numbered, All Streets are 60 feet wide the Alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide and run at right angles, said Lots are laid out by John Rogers.

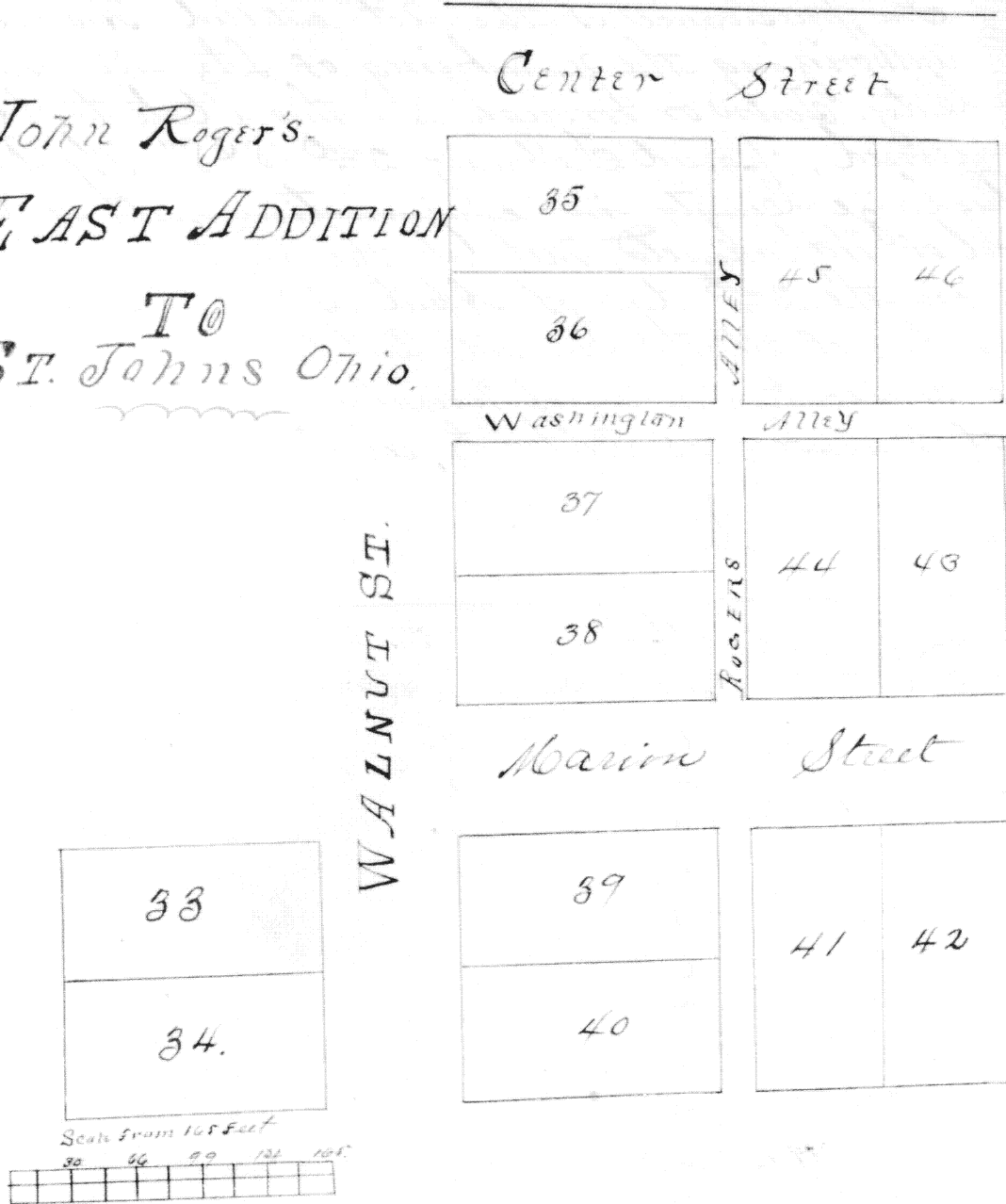
