

This Plat is a survey of the balance of the quarter section in which the town of Amsterdam is situated, being the North east quarter of section Twenty two Township seven South of Range four East, Mercer County Ohio.

Parallelogram of 20 Acres is the Town of Amsterdam, the Lot of ten Acres adjoining is the lot belonging to Henry Smith, the Lots then numbered from one to ten, the length of lines with their corners are described on the lines, as also every necessary information for finding the survey. A Stone is planted at the corner of Lot No. 4 at the original corner of the quarter section on the North line. Done correct to the best of my knowledge

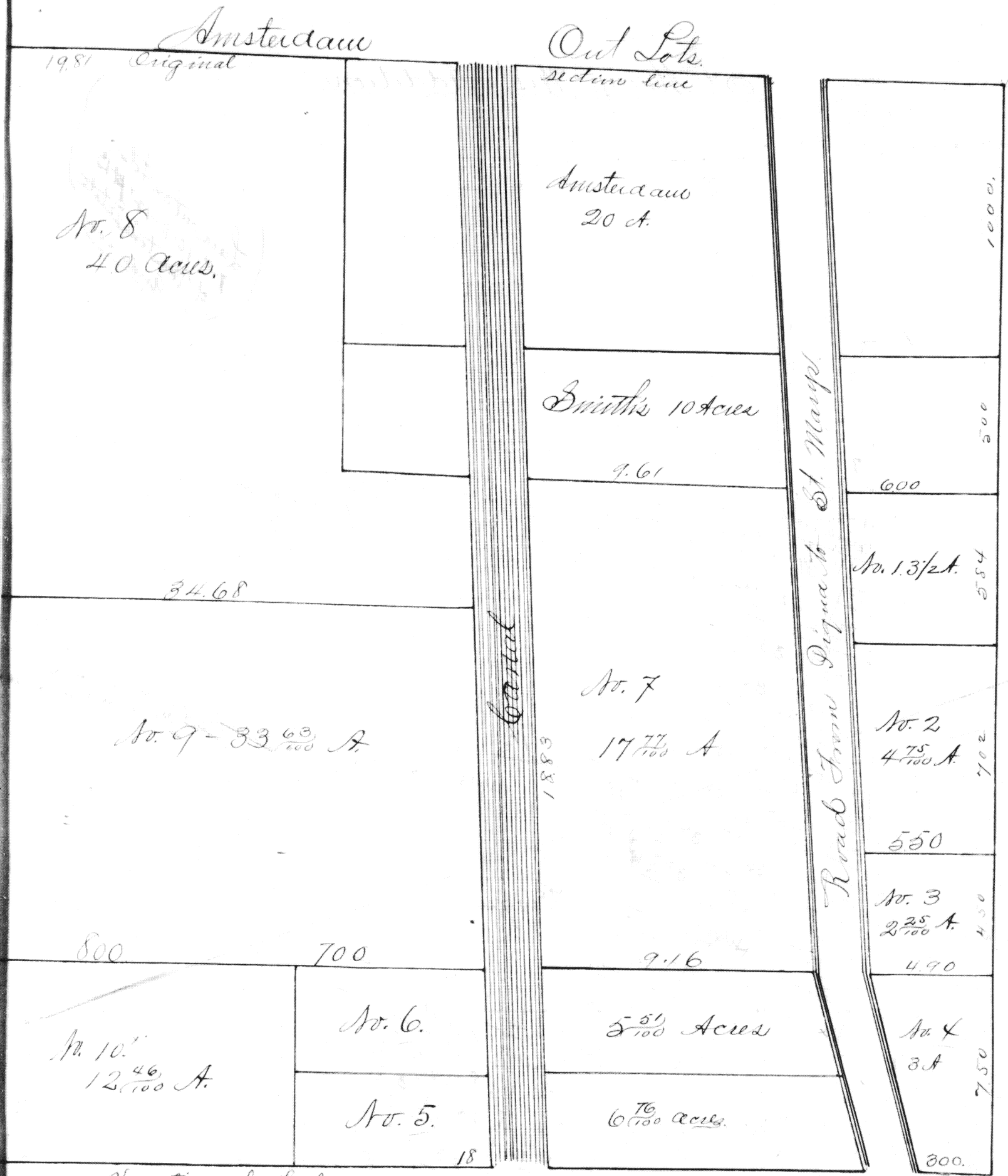

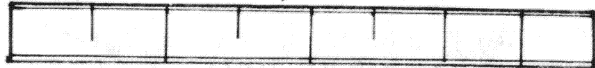
