

St. Mary, East Addition

See Dec 37 p 412

This Addition is laid out on the South half of the North East quarter of Section three, T. 6. R. 4 E. and comprises 29 blocks divided into Lots as follows, Block No. 15, 7 & 14 each contain 12 Lots, Those fronting on Spring Street are each 44 by 123, all others in said Block are 41 feet in front by 132 deep, except Lot No. 7 in Block No. 14 which is 94 links on the Alley, Block 2, 3, 4 & 6 are 42 feet in front and 132 feet deep, except fractional Lots, which have their dimensions designated on the lines, on the line of the

Evidently intended for Block 1, 5, 7, 14.



Map in red ink, No. 8, 10, 16, 23 & 24 are all 44 feet in front by 132 deep except the fractional Lots in said Block, All other Blocks viz: 9, 10, 11, 12, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 25, 26 are 42 feet in front by 132 deep, except fractional which are designated as aforesaid, in red ink.

The State of Ohio, Sherwood Bass Before me, an appointed Judge in and for said County of Mercer personally called William S. Keckert and acknowledged the Plat to be his, etc. dated April 30th - Before me, Robert Linzee an appointed Judge of Mercer Co. O.

All the Streets are four rods wide, those running from the River are laid precisely parallel to the Town Plat (original) except Spring Street which is 34 links to the N. and runs N. 25 W. all Streets running parallel with the river bear South 27° east. The alleys are one rod wide, a stone is planted at the S.E. cor. of Lot No. 1 which is seven chains from the River. Variation of E. line 4°, variation of N. & S. line 3° 42'. The survey was performed at great disadvantage through the brush woods. I do certify the survey to be done correctly to the best of my knowledge and belief.
