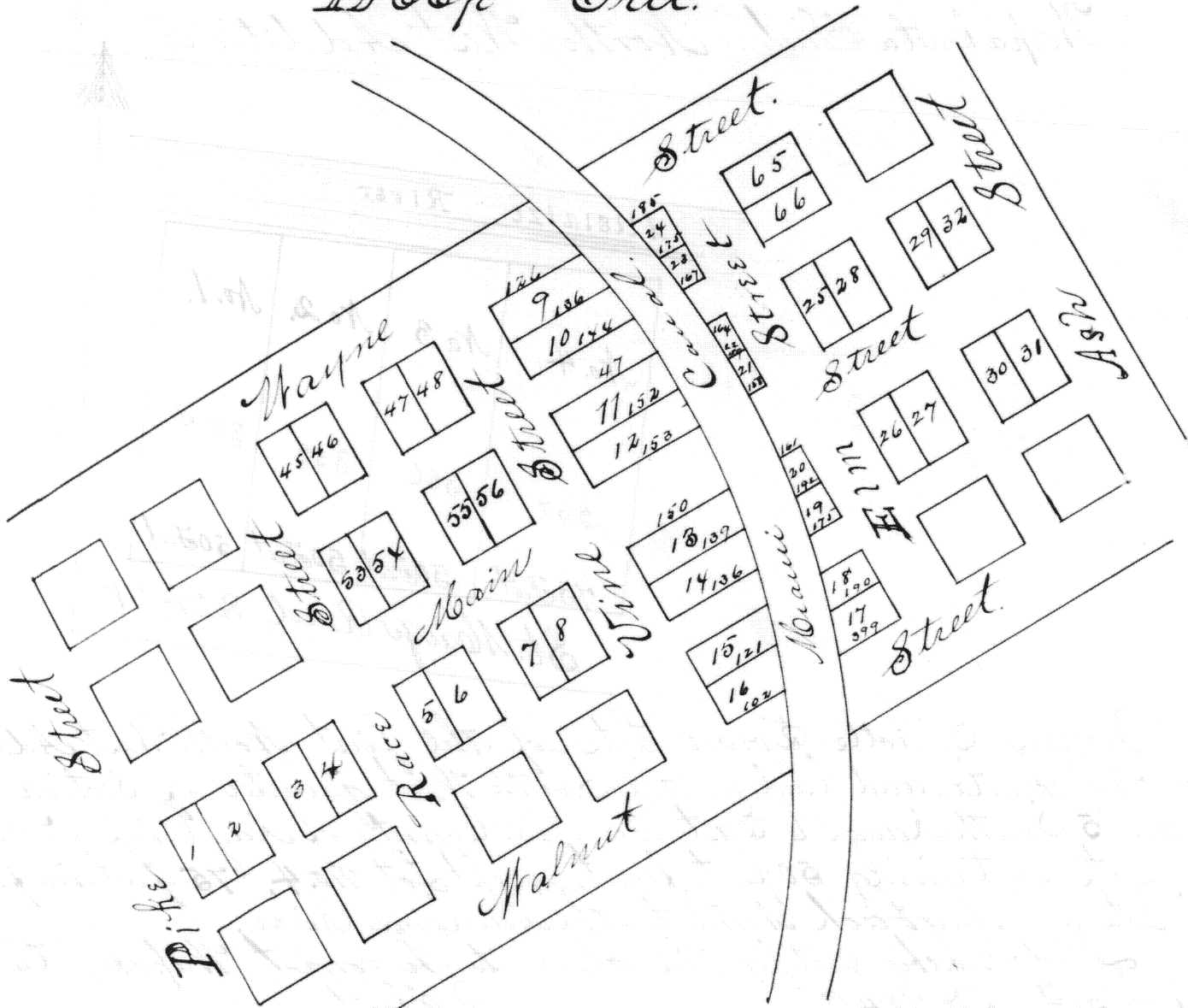


Deep Cut.



The Town of Deep Cut is laid on the East half of the South West quarter and the West half of South East quarter of Section 25, Town 4 South Range 4 East of first principal Meridian. It contains 32 Lots, all of which except those adjoining the Canal are each 66 feet wide and one hundred and fifty two feet long. The Lots on the Canal are the same width and the length of their sides in links is marked on the map in red ink, now with small figures. Main Street is 66 feet wide and bears S. 60° W. all other streets are each 59 1/10 feet wide and run parallel to or at right angles, to Main Street as designated on the map, the Alleys are all 16 1/2 feet wide. The blocks and squares not numbered on the map are not intended to be made a part of the town plat. Corner stones at N.W. 9 and S.W. 16.
