

JOSEPH SAWYER'S: West Addition to Wapakoneta.

The within plat represents Sawyer's West Addition to the Town of Wapakoneta, Auglaize County Ohio, as surveyed by me April A.D. 1858, and is laid off on the West part of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section No. 32 T. 5 S. R. 6 East

The Lots are all 50 feet front by one hundred and fifty feet deep except where otherwise shown on the plat. The Streets are 66 and the alleys 16.5 feet wide.

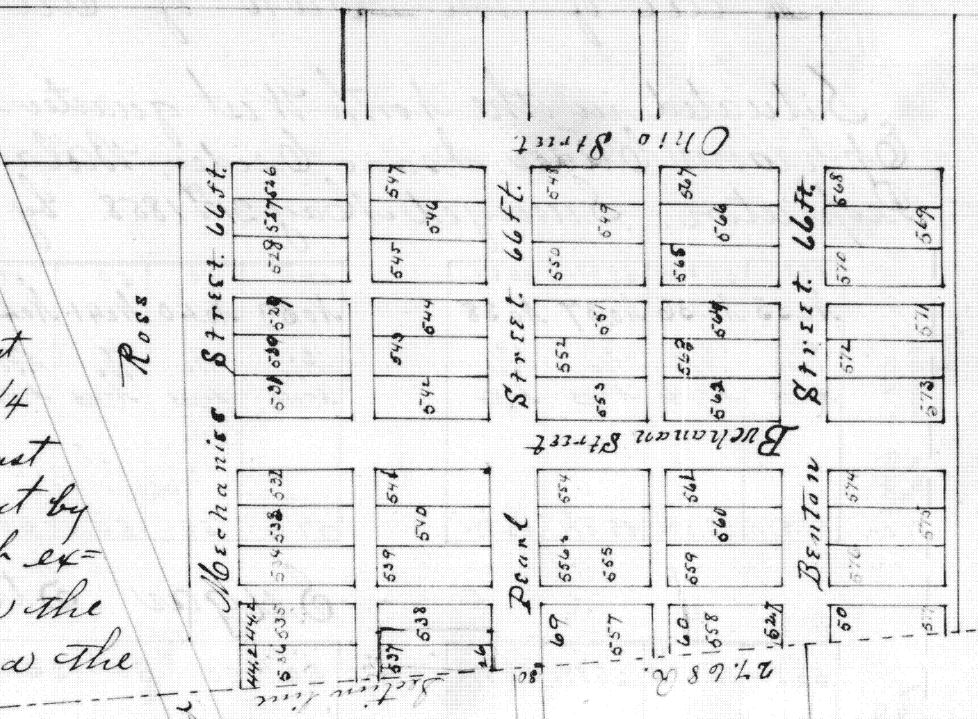

A Monument is placed at the South East corner of Lot No. 541.
