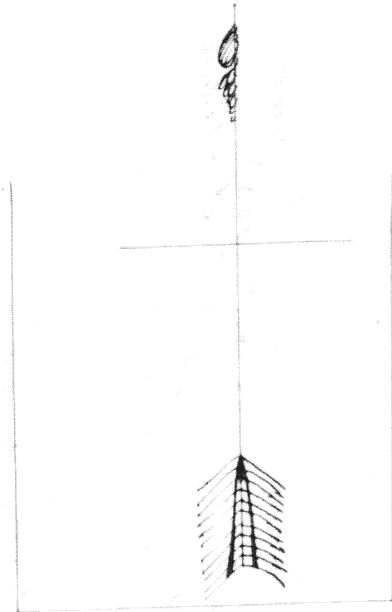


Isaac Crider's 1st South Addition to the Town of Crider'sville.

The within represents Isaac Crider's South Addition to the Town of Crider'sville, Auglaize County Ohio, and is laid off in the North West quarter of the North West quarter of Section number thirty-five, Town four South Range six East. All lots are 50 by 150 feet except two fractional ones, next to the Rail Road, which their proper width shown on the within plat. The alleys are 16 feet wide, the streets as marked on the Plat. A Monument is planted at the North East corner of Lot number sixty-six (66).
