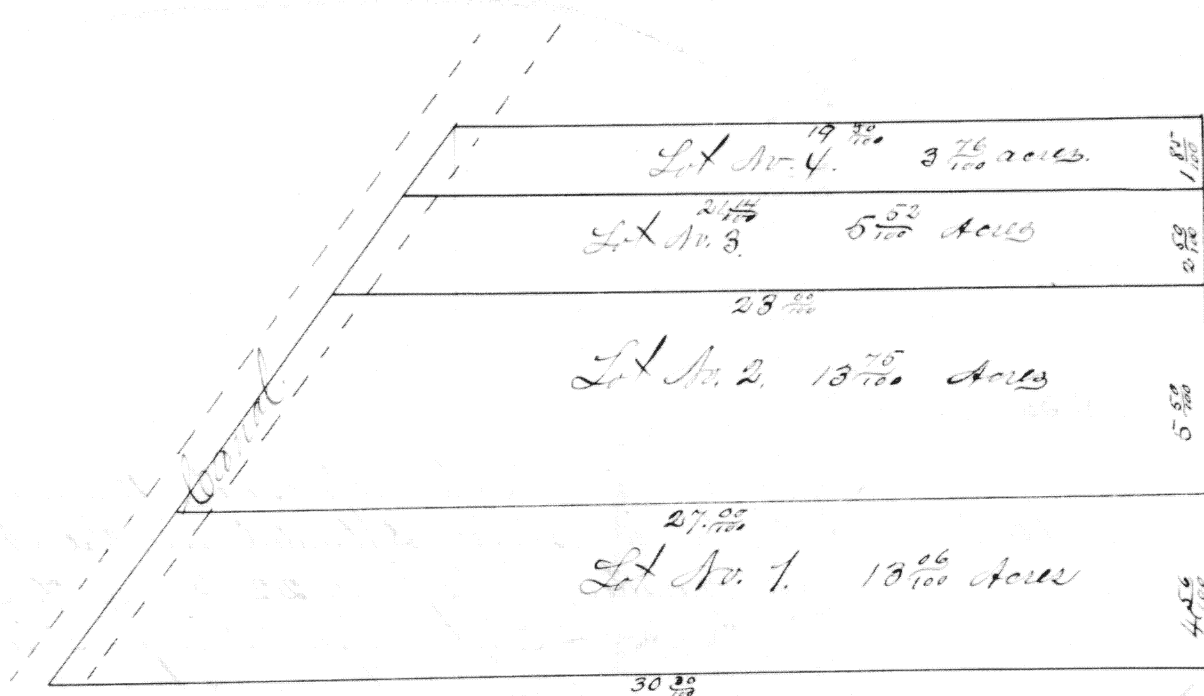


Subdivision of Plat of Section 11 S. 7. S. R. 4. E.



This Map represents the Vicks Subdivision situated and described as follows: Commencing at the South East quarter part of the North West quarter of Section Eleven (11), Town seven (7) South Range four (4) East, running North with fourteen chains and forty one links, thence West with nineteen and a half chains to the middle of the canal, thence Southwardly along the center of the canal to the half section line, thence East to the place of beginning with thirty chains and thirty links. Said land is divided into four lots, and the width and depth of each lot are given on plat, also the number of acres. The distances are given in chains, "Scale, one inch to four chains"
