A Plat and field notes of the East half of the South East quarter of Section No. 28 Town 7. North Range 4 East, Subdivision of Joseph Enneking and Elizabeth Enneking.

Explanatory Notes.

The corner marked A on the above plat is the S.E. corner of section No. 28. T. 7 R. 4 E. The small figures along the line denote lengths of lines in chains and links. West Street and Cross Street are 30 feet wide each, and run with right angles either East or West from the South to the north line or from the East to the West line on the above plat. North Alley is 15 feet wide. Stones planted at every corner.
