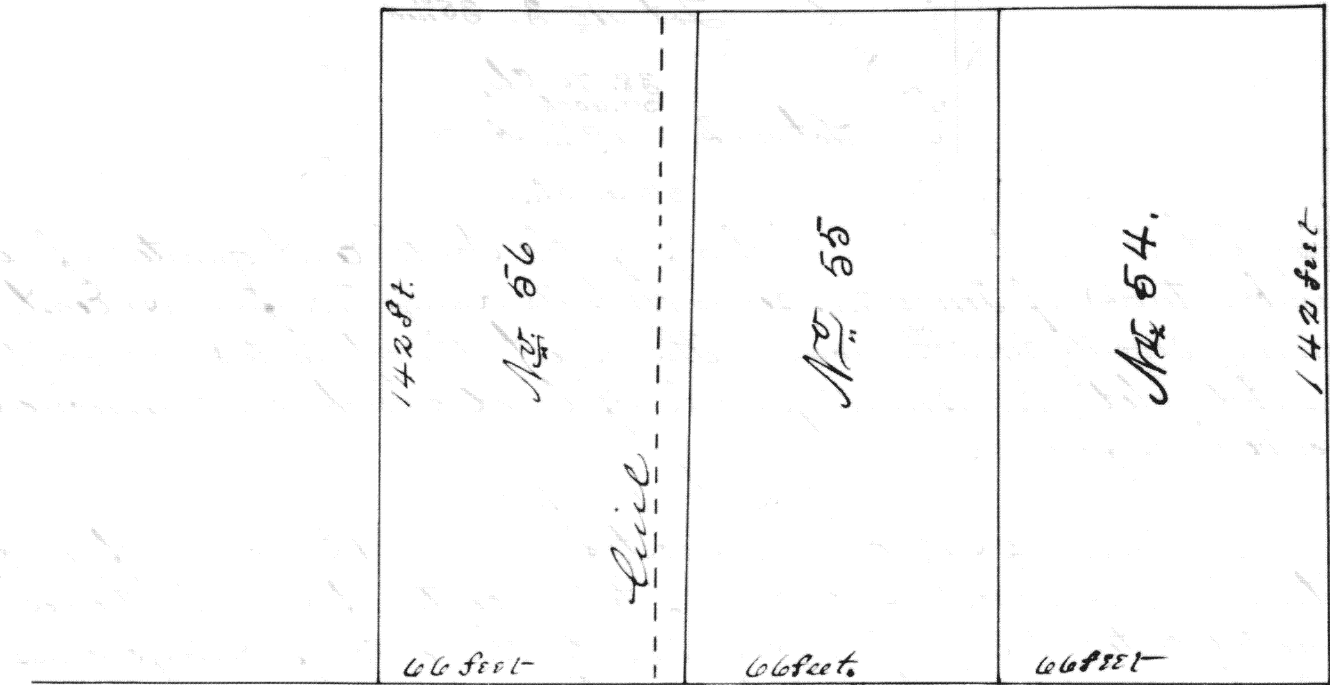
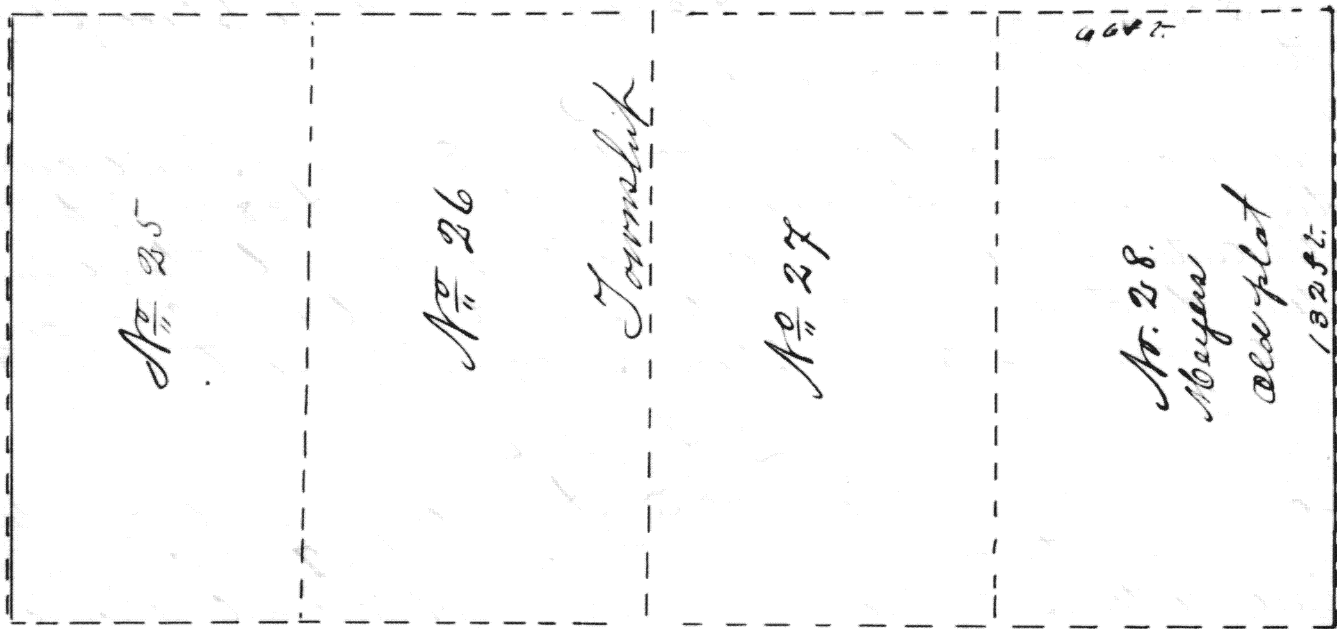


William Bitter's Addition to the Town
