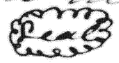


VauKorn's Plat laying out River Alley
in the Town of Wapakoneta.



The above named River Alley is dedicated twenty feet wide running from Auglaize Street to the Auglaize River, the east line thereof being a continuation of the East line of Park Street and being made upon the condition that the Town Council of Wapakoneta abandon all claim to ever reopen the old Lima Road between Park Street and the track of the Dayton and Michigan Rail Road, and sink under a substantial brick sewer ten feet below the sidewalk of Auglaize Street so as to allow the walls of a building to cross the arch with a cellar nine feet in depth thereby conveying the water of the sewers located on the West side of Park Street to the River without doing damage to the building lot west of said Alley. This dedication to take place from and after the acceptance thereof by the Town Council and upon the conditions herein contained.
