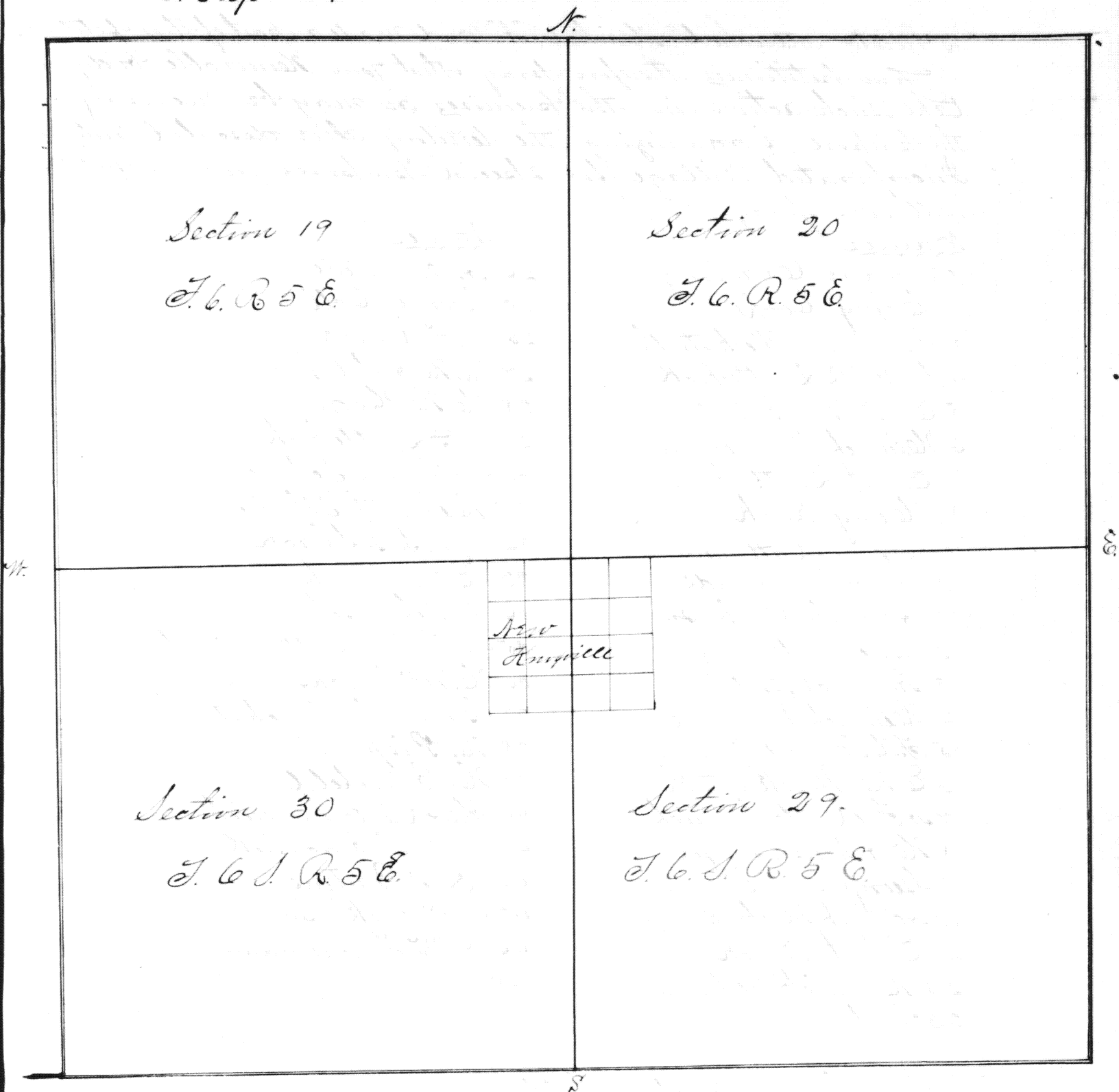


## Map A



Incorporation of  
New Knoxville Co.

To the Hon. Board of Commissioners of  
Auglaize County and State of Ohio

Your petitioners respectfully represent that they are inhabi-  
tants of said County residing on and adjacent to territory laid  
off into village lots a plot of which has been made and recorded  
situated in said County of Auglaize and State of Ohio to wit:  
Section number nineteen (19), Twenty (20) Twenty nine (29) and  
thirty (30) all in Washington Township, and Township six @ South  
Range five (5) East. That the supposed number of inhabitants  
is about three hundred and five (305), that they desire said  
territory to be organized into an incorporated village for  
special purposes by the name New Knoxville, the follow-  
ing named persons residing on said territory are hereby au-  
thorized to act as agents in behalf of your petitioners in the  
premises, to wit: Mr. Huck Junr. Mrs. Fennema and G. W. Ho.  
Snethkaup. An accurate map of the territory above described

is hereto attached headed "A" and made a part of this petition.

For petitioners therefore pray that your Honorable body will take such action in the premises as may be necessary for the purpose of organizing the territory above described into an Incorporated Village for special purposes as your petitioners will ever pray.

In the Matter of the petition  
for the Incorporation of the Town  
of New Knoxville Auglaize Co. O.

Monday June 1<sup>st</sup> 1874

This day came H. H. Suthkamp & al. and presented to the Board a petition praying for the Incorporation of New Knoxville in said County which was duly received and ordered to be filed in the Auditor's office of said County of Auglaize there to be kept subject to the inspection of any person or persons interested. And it was further ordered that W. Kuck, H. Venneman and H. H. Suthkamp the agents of said petitioners give notice containing the substance of said petition in accordance with the Statutes in such cases made and provided, that the said petition and application will be heard at the Auditor's office in said County of Auglaize on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of August A.D. 1874 to which time the matter is adjourned Monday August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1874. The Board met pursuant to adjournment. In the Matter of the Application for the Incorporation of New Knoxville Ohio:

August 3<sup>rd</sup> AD 1874

This day said petition came on to be further heard pursuant to the order of this Board heretofore made in the premises, and upon examination and consideration of said petition, we do find that it contains all the matters required by law and that all the statements therein made are true. That the name proposed for such corporation to wit: New Knoxville is appropriate, that the limits thereof have been accurately described, and that the same are not unreasonably large or small, and the map or plat thereof correctly made, that the persons whose names are subscribed thereto are legal voters residing on said territory. That this notice of the time and place of the hearing thereof has been given by said agents as heretofore ordered by this Board, and that more than fifty qualified voters reside on said territory. It is therefore ordered that said petition be granted, and that said territory be organized as an Incorporated Village for special purposes, and that the same be named and known as New Knoxville, and it is further ordered that the Auditor of this County make out a full and complete certified transcript of all the proceedings and orders of this Board herein, and after the same shall be signed by us he came it to be delivered together with the petition and map accompanying said petition and all the other papers on file to the Recorder of this County to be by him placed on file in his office in pursuance of law.
