thence South two miles, to the South West corner of section nineteen
(19) Same town and range, thence East one and one half miles to the
South East corner of the west half of section twenty (20) Same town
and range, thence North two miles to the North East corner of
the west half of section seventeen (17) same town and Range,
thence West to the place of beginning in Auglaize County Ohio
to be organized into an Incorporated Village, for special pur-
poses, under and by the name of Wagnersfield. Your petitioners
further represent, that the supposed number of inhabitants re-
siding on said territory is about two hundred and seventy, we

is herewith attached and made a part of this petition

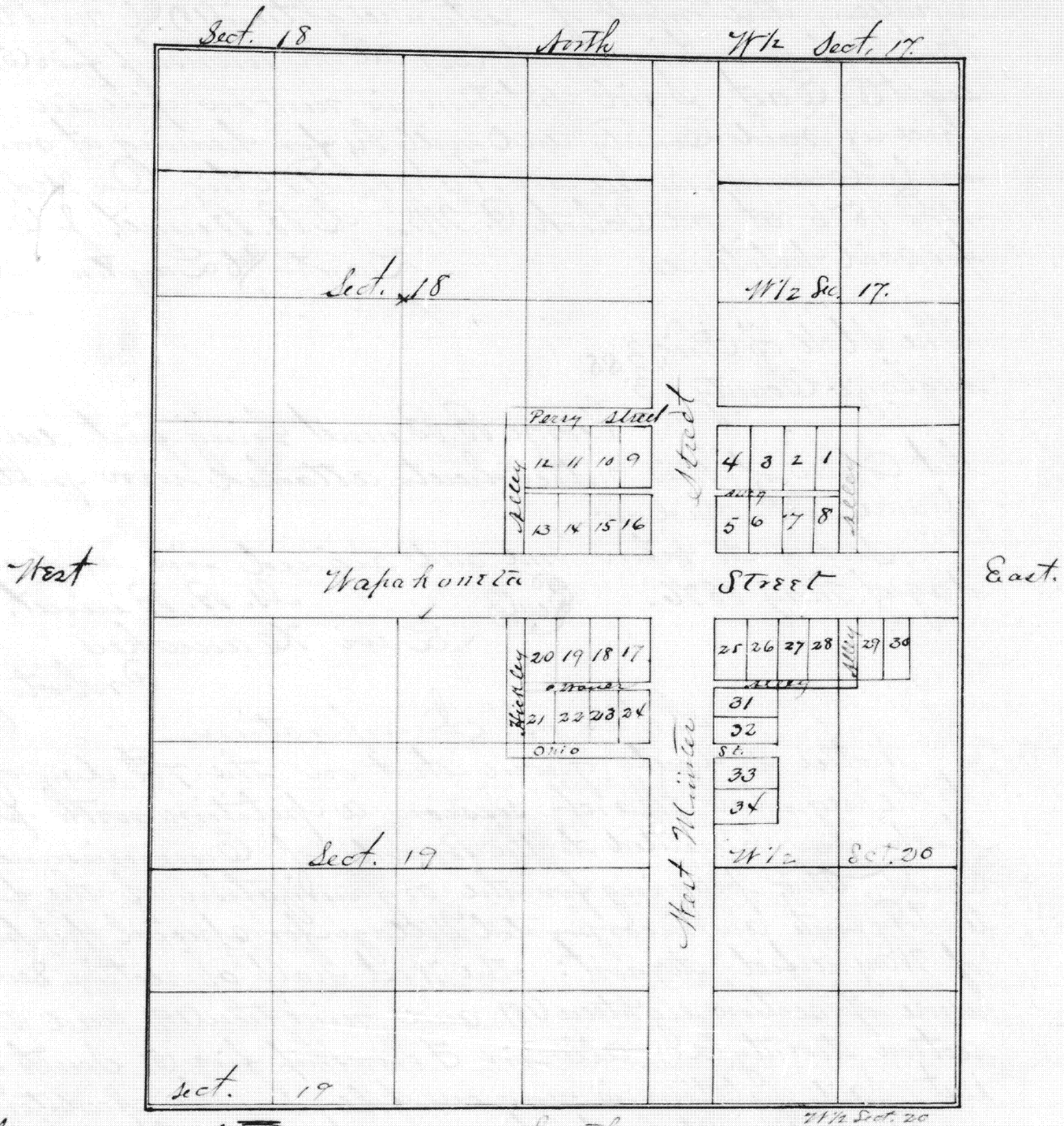

In the Matter of the Incorporation of the town of Waynesfield Auglaize County Ohio for special purposes.

Before the Auglaize County Commissioners.

This 10th day of May A.D. 1876 said petition came on for hearing and said Commissioners being duly satisfied that due notice of the time and place of the hearing of the same by proper proof on file has been

given in pursuance of a former order of said Commissioners and in accordance with law, and further finding that said petition contains all the matter required by law, and that its statements are true, that the name proposed for such corporation, to wit: Waynesfield is appropriate that the limits thereof have been accurately described and that the same are not unreasonable large or small, and that the map or plot thereof is accurately made, that the persons whose names are subscribed thereto are legal voters residing on said territory, and that there are at least fifty qualified voters residing therein.

It is therefore ordered by said Commissioners that said territory be and the same is hereby organized into an Incorporated Village for special purposes under and by name of Waynesfield as prayed for in said petition. And the Auditor of said County of Auglaize is hereby ordered to cause a complete transcript to be made out, to be signed by said Commissioners of all the proceedings herein and cause the same together with all the papers on file to be delivered to the Recorder of said County as provided by law.
