

Ordinance No. 4.

Whereas on the 15th day of June A.D. 1877.
 A Majority of the qualified voters of the In-
 corporated Village of St. Johns, Auglaize County Ohio,
 at a special Election held for that purpose voted for
 a Surrender of the corporate rights and Franchises of
 said Village, Therefore, Resolved by the Trustees of said
 Village, for special purposes that said rights and
 franchises are hereby surrendered, and said Village of
 St. Johns is hereby restored and re-instated in all
 the rights and privileges held the same prior to the
 Incorporation thereof, Done this 22nd day of June
 A.D. 1877.
