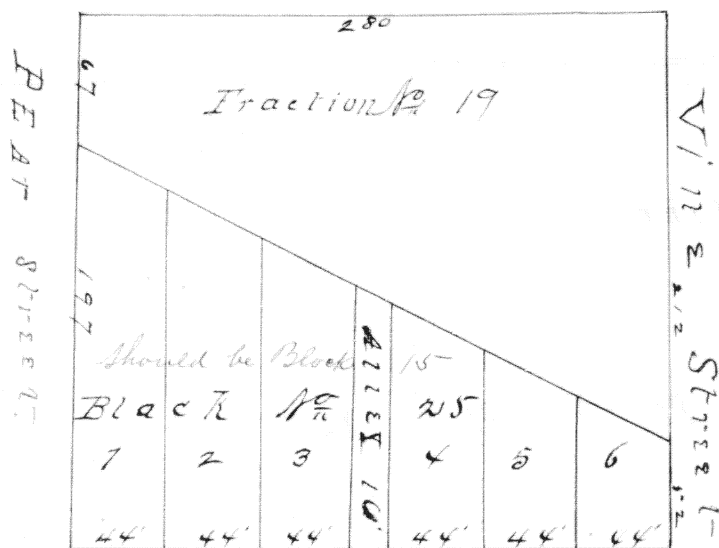

## Street

These two plates represent Block No. 25 of the East Addition and the Fraction No. 19, all of the Town of St. Marys Anglaise County Ohio. The object thereof is to show that plat No. 1. Represents the tracts of land above mentioned, and the plat No. 2. represents the tracts of land after alteration by putting both tracts of land into one body and then subdividing this tract again into six lots. The sizes and distance of six lots and Alley are given on plat, also the number of lots - Scale 1/8 inch to 25 feet.
