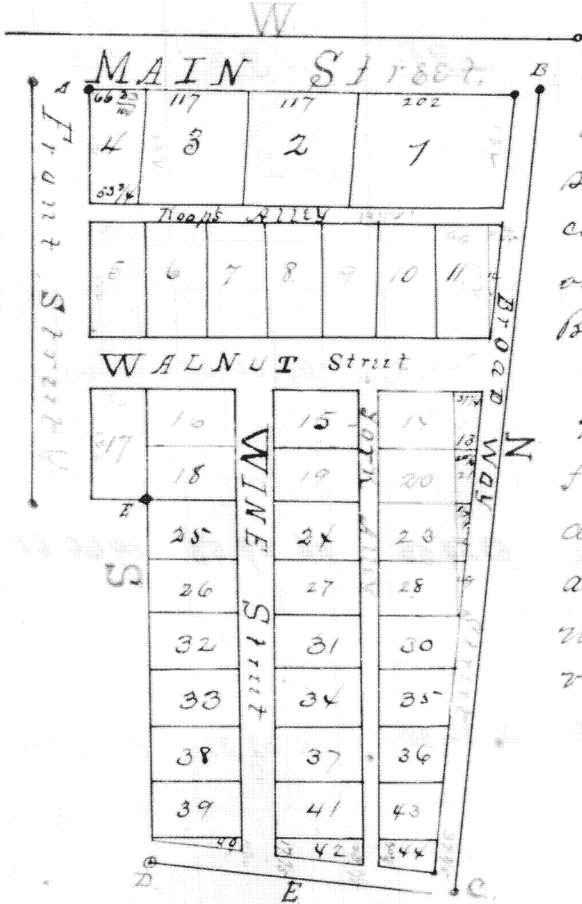
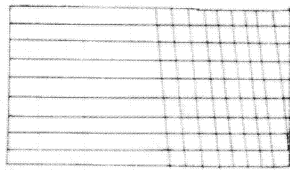


William & Benjamin Hoop & John Bosche's

The undersigned William & Benjamin Hoop and John F. Bosche do acknowledge that this survey of our land was done by our advice and consent for the purpose therein specified and witness our names, William & Benjamin Hoop and John F. Bosche, sealed by them.

Before me Wm. Fiske a Justice of the Peace in and for said County, personally appeared William and Benjamin Hoop and John F. Bosche, and acknowledged the signing and sealing of the within east addition of Bremen to be their voluntary act & deed this 22nd of June A.D. 1848.

Plat of William & Benjamin Hoop and John F. Bosche's Town Lots, is the east addition to Bremen, and laid out on the east half of North East quarter of Section 15. Township 7 South of Range 4 East in the County of Auglar Ohio. North and South Streets are true decuss west of magnetic north angle. The Front and Walnut Street are 66 feet wide. The wine Street is 48 feet wide. The Alley is 16 1/2 feet wide, 20 feet is given to each section line, on the north and east side Lots No. 1, 2 & 3, 117 by 132, 4, 66 3/4, 53 1/2 by 132 feet, Lot Nos. 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, & 17 are 66 feet wide and 132 1/2 feet long. Lot No. 12, 11 1/5, 13, 27 1/5, 21, 20 1/5, 22, 12 1/5, 29, 5 3/4, 40, 11 1/5, 42, 28 1/5, 44, 37 1/5 feet wide, all other lots are 66 feet wide and 99 feet long. Stones are placed on the corner A, B, C, D, E, F. Commencing with letter A on the South West corner of said Addition; Lot Survey, thence North to B, thence East to C, thence South to D, thence West to E, thence South to F, thence West to letter A again.
