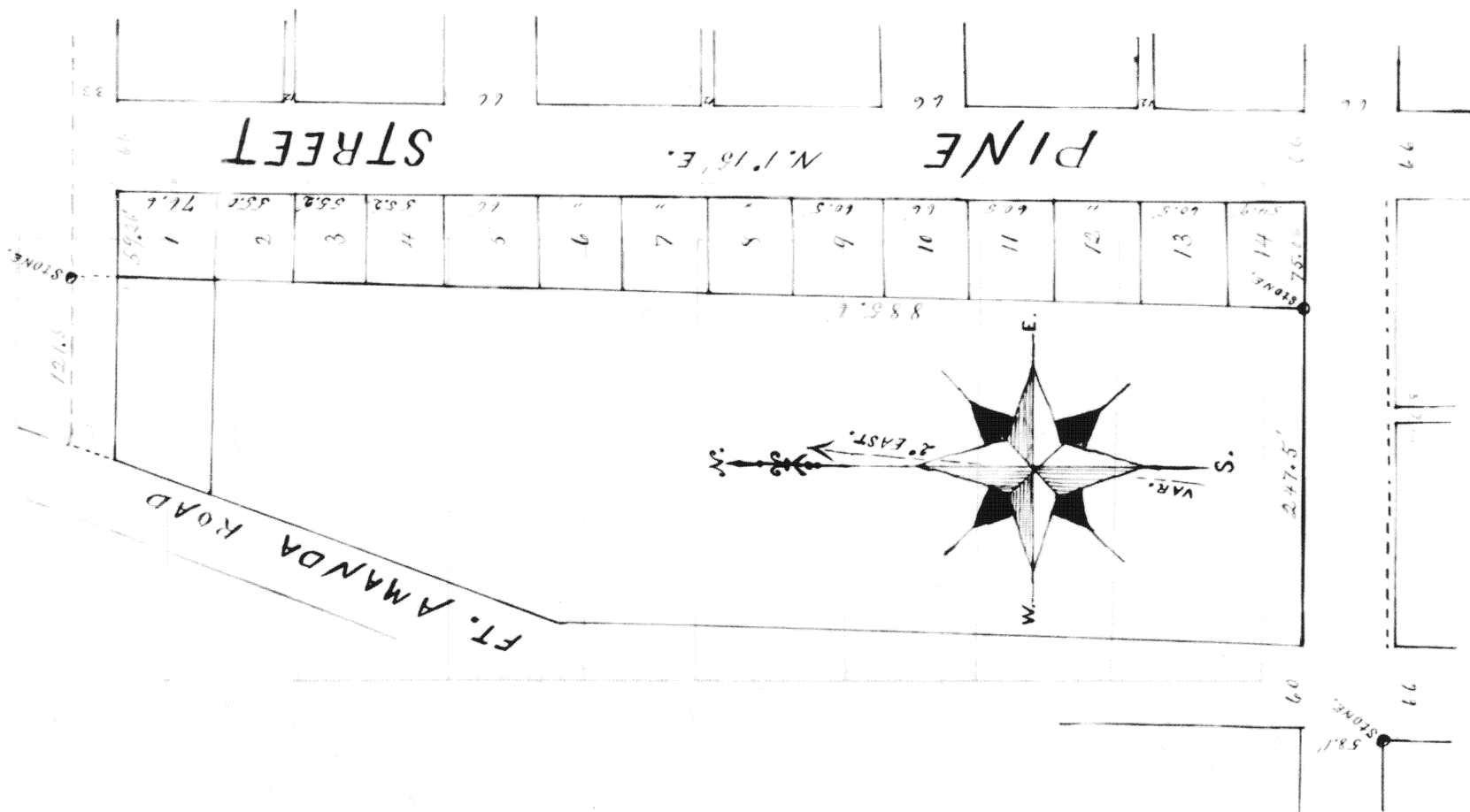

I hereby certify that the above is a correct Map of the Subdivision of Out Lot N^o 17 (Frac N^o 9 of old numbering) in the Village of St. Marys, Auglaize County, Ohio, as surveyed and staked out by me for D. Armstrong Esq, during April 1887. The streets and avenues are 66 ft wide except Oil and Gas Sts which are as noted; Alleys are 12 ft. wide. Pine, Pear, Vine and Scott Sts, are continuations of the same in Armstrongs East Addition. Oil St and Cleveland and Hendricks aves are parallel with Columbia Street. The dimensions are given in feet and hundredths.
