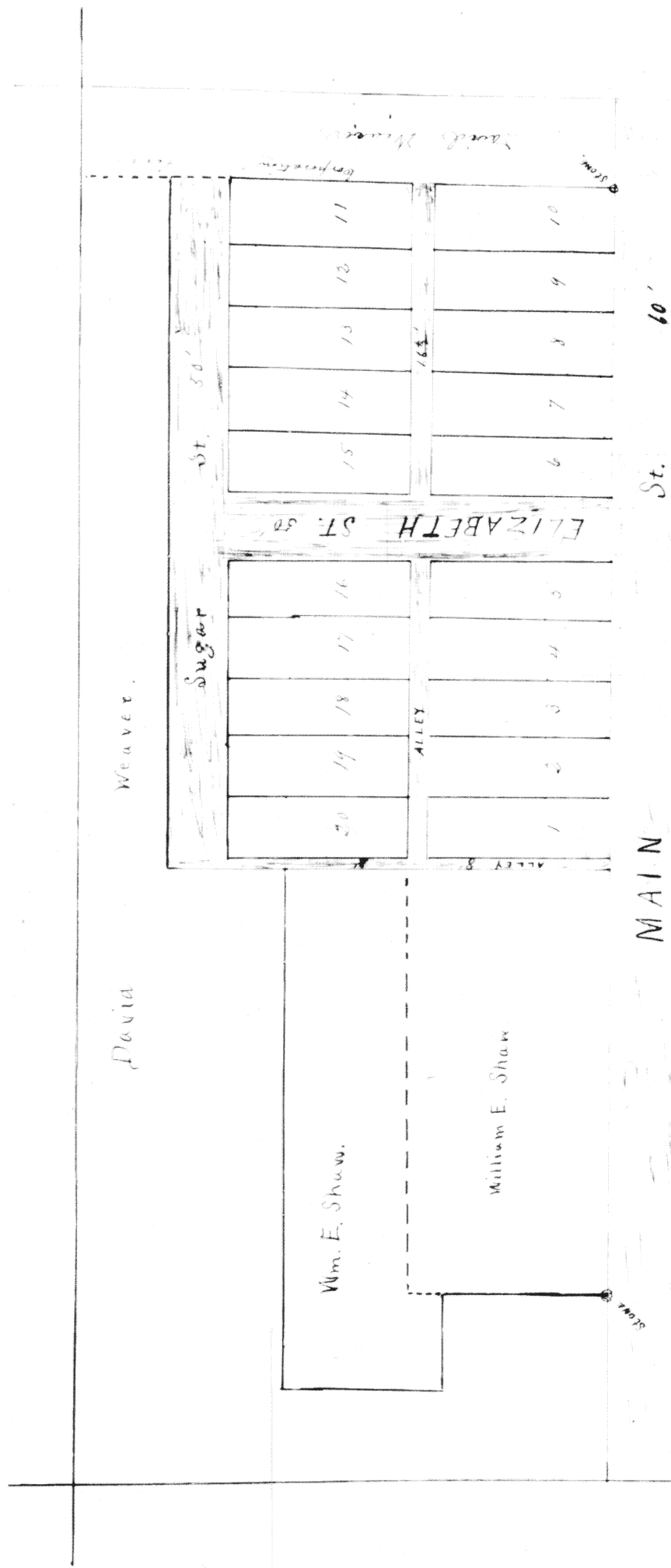

I wish to certify that the above year's results correctly. The south-east part of the south-west quarter of section thirty-five, Town four north, Range six east, as indicated by me at the request of David Haines, on the 13th day of March, 1888. Lots were all fifty feet by one hundred and fifty, streets and alleys were paralleled on at right angles to Main Street, and of the width indicated. Samuel Craig, Surveyor.

I now all know by past presents, that I David Weaver of Angletide Brining, Ohio, do make public and adopt the colored portion of the aforesaid plat of subdivision made by James Craig, surveyor, of the west east part of the south east part of the south west quarter of section thirty-two, town four south, range six east, in the town of Bradenville, Angletide Brining Ohio of which I am proprietor, and dedicate to the use of the public forever as highway, the streets and alleys therein indicated and named.
