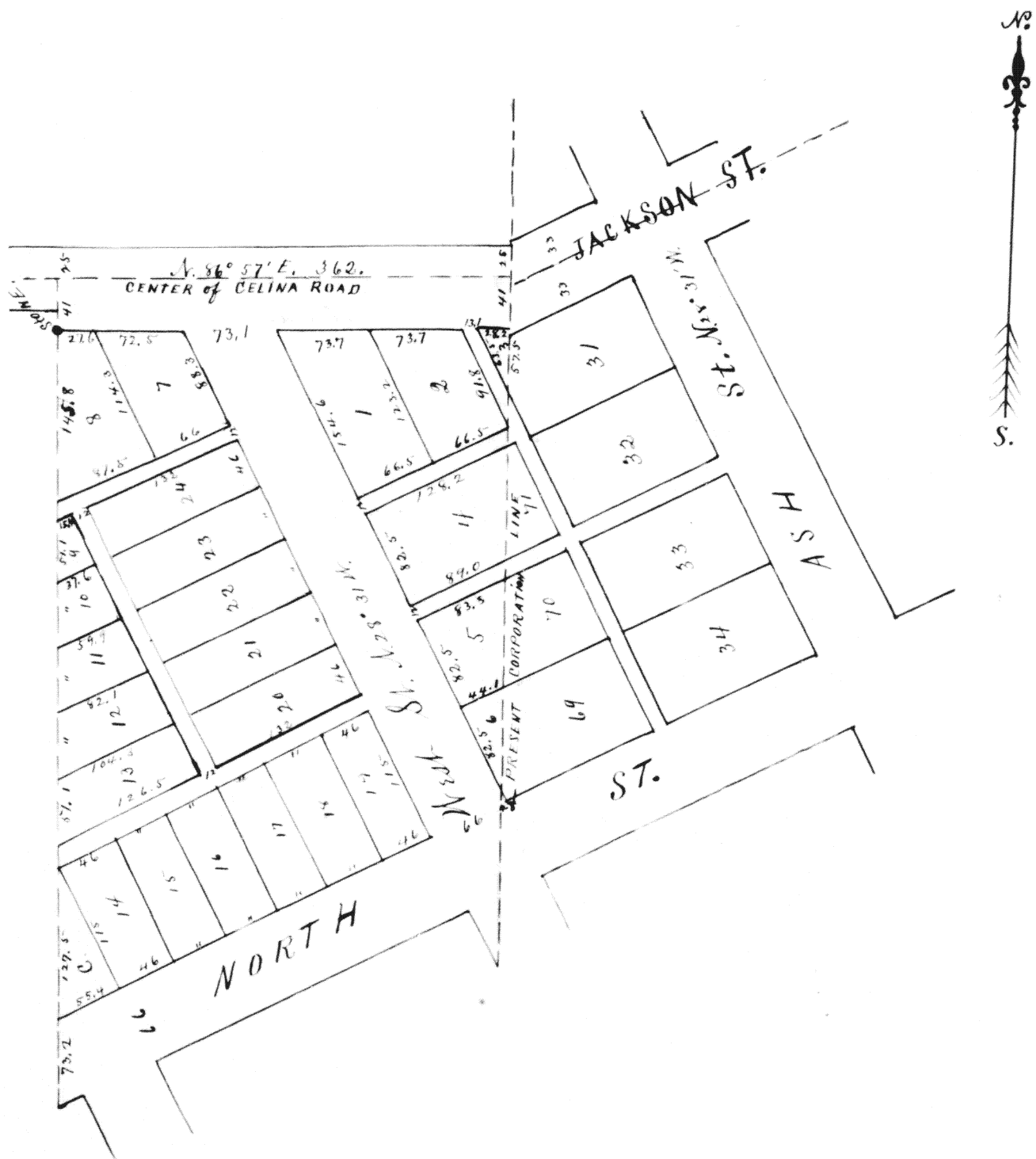




The Plot on this page and Page 311 Represents

 Kuesch Kuffman & Co's addition to the village of St. Marys Auglaize
 County, Ohio, as surveyed and plotted by me during April 1888. It covers
 14 3/4 acres off the south east part of Sec. 4 T. 6 S. R. 4 E. Lots 73, 74 of west
 addition and lots 26, 27, 28, 29, & 30 of Jos. Harrington's Resubdivision of
 Landon and Donnan's subdivision. The streets are continuation of the same in
 West Addition. Dimensions are indicated by feet and hundredths, bearing
 in degrees and minutes of compass ^{variation} 2° East.
