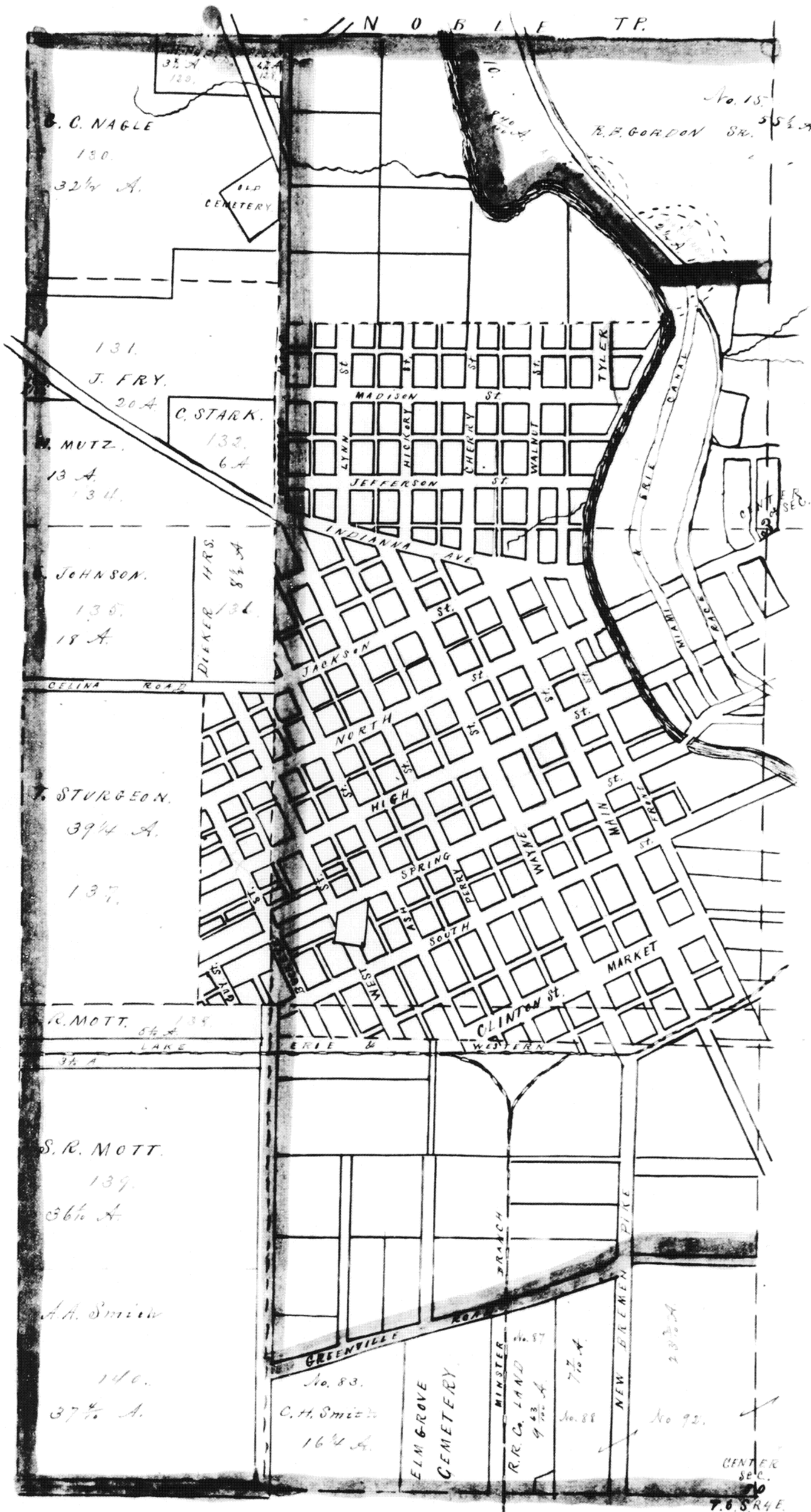
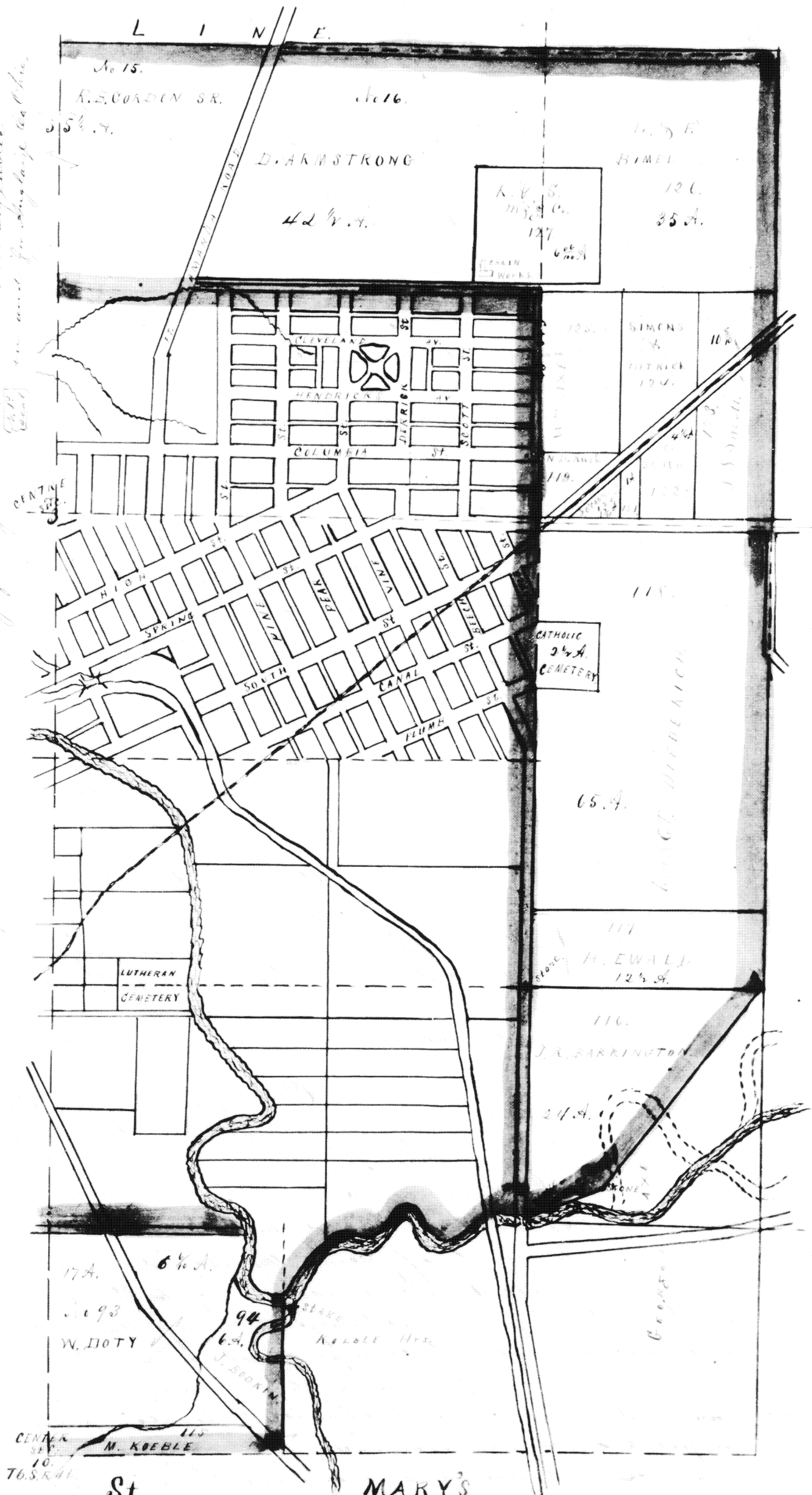

Petition.

To the Honorable, the County Commissioners of Auglaize County Ohio:
 The Village of St. Marys, Auglaize County, Ohio would respectfully represent
 unto your Honors, that it is duly incorporated under the laws of Ohio,
 that on the 2nd day of May 1885 an ordinance was duly passed by the Village
 Council authorizing the annexation of the hereinafter described territory,
 and conforming, and directing the undersigned Charles F. Dullack, Village
 Recorder to prosecute all proper proceedings to effect such annexation.
 A certified copy of said ordinance and an accurate map or plot of
 said territory sought to be annexed is hereto attached marked A and B,
 and made a part of this petition and application. The contiguous territory
 sought to be annexed is described as follows, to-wit: All that part
 of section three (3) range 10 S. 11th South Range Townships, east by and north
 of the present Corporation line, Case, to the north half, of the west half, of
 section number two (2) same township and range; Also, the west
 half of the north half of section number three (3) all of the north half of
 Sec. ten (10) not already included in said Corporation; Also, the north
 east quarter of section four (4) same township and range. Also the following
 land running as the north line of sec number four (4) running along
 said line north to the East River Road, thence along said line of
 said plot to the north corner of said line, thence east along the West li-
 ne of said section three (3) all in township 10 S. range 10 E.
 your county Auglaize County Ohio. Witness my hand and the seal of the Village of Saint

Ordinance No. 5.

That in order to carry out and authorizing the enlargement
 of the Corporate limits of Saint Marys, and annexation of
 territory thereto, Sec. 1 - It is ordained by the Council of the in-
 corporated Village of Saint Marys Auglaize County Ohio, that
 the hereinafter named tract or parcels of land, and lots, and sub-
 divisions of said lots, shall be to the present Corporation, and
 be annexed to said Corporation for corporate purposes, and
 be subject to all existing ordinances now, or which may hereafter
 be enacted, and that we hereby authorize the annexation of the same
 to-wit: All that part of section three (3) town 10 S. range 10 E.

east, lying north of the present Corporation line; also the west half of the west half of section number nine (9), same township and ranges; also west half of north west quarter of section eleven (11) all of the north half of section ten (10) not already included in said Corporation; also the north east quarter of section nine; also the following, commencing at the half section line of section number four (4) running along said line north to the Port Hope Pike; thence along said line of said Pike, to the Noble Township line; thence east along, the Noble Township line to section line (2)

Wherein it is further provided that Charles H. Bullock, Village, Solicitor be and he hereby is appointed and authorized to prosecute all proceedings to effect such annexation.

Sec. III That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same hereby are repealed.

Sec. IV That the ordinance be effect and be in force from and after its passage and legal publication. Done at Council Chamber this 24 day of May A.D. 1885.

Journal Entry. August 8th, 1888.
 In the matter of the Annexation of Territory to the town of St. Marys, Ohio. This matter coming on to be heard this day Chas. P. Dullack, Counsel for incorporation produced a notice with proof of the service of the same as required by law, and being further heard upon the petition and accompanying plat and papers and the Commissioners of said County of Auglaize finding that the same contained all the matters required that said that the amount of territory asked to be annexed is excessive and order and decree the annexation of the following territory, to-wit: the striking out of the petition & plat all but the following to-wit: As it is solved by the council of the Village of Saint Marys, Ohio, that the Village Attorney, Chas. P. Dullack, be and hereby is instructed to amend his petition in the matter of Annexation of territory to the Village of St. Marys, Ohio, so as to describe the following territory in accordance with the decision of the Hon. County Commissioners, to-wit: (1) that part of section three (3), township 16th south of range four east lying north of the present conservation line. Also, the west half of the west half of section four (4), same township and range, then commencing on the quarter section line between sections numbers 9 and 11, running thence southerly to a stone on the land of John Berkingham in section 11, thence south 29th degrees west seven hundred and 20 feet to a stone in the south west corner of the north west quarter of the north west quarter of said section 11, thence easterly along the east branch of the Saint Marys river, to a stake on the north and south quarter line of the north east quarter, thence south one degree east along said quarter line eight hundred and fifty eight (558) feet to the east and west half section line of said section number 11, thence west along said half section line of section number 11 and mile 19th to the eastern north east south west corner of said section number 19, and thence south to the Noble Township line; thence east along said township line to section three (3), all in township six (6) south range four east, Auglaize County, O.
 And that the petition and plat of said territory as amended be amended so as to conform to this decision.
