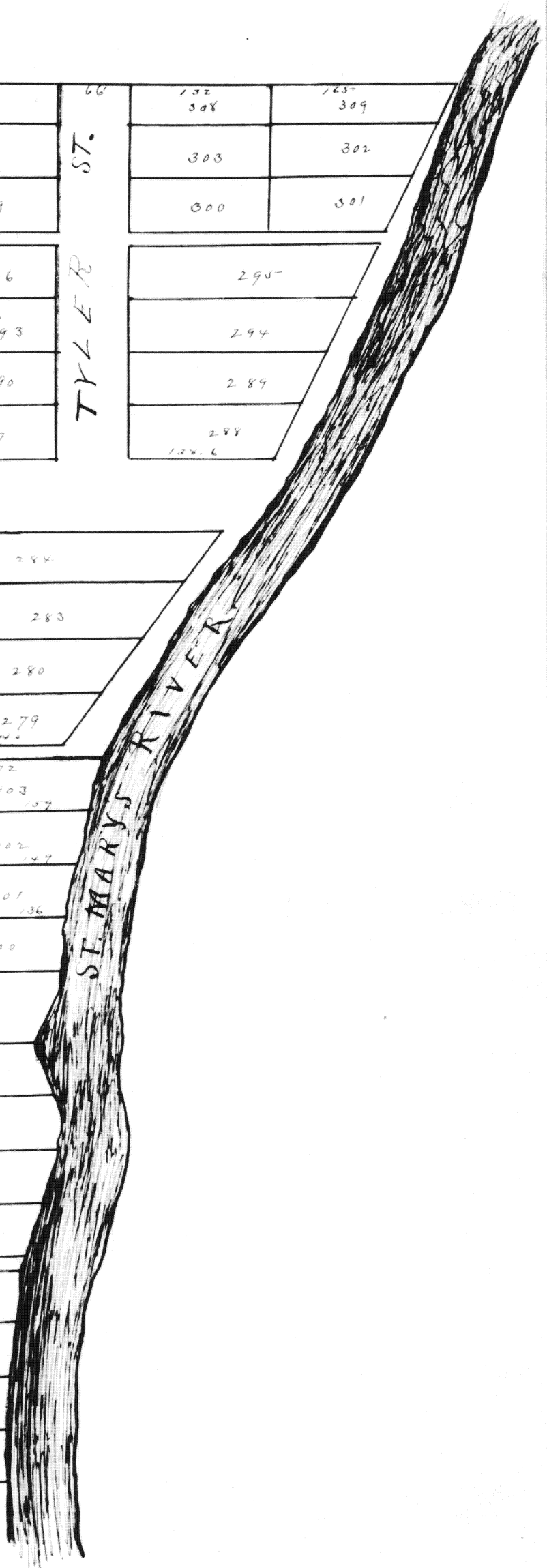

other things is the following, to wit: That on the day the Cause came on
for hearing upon the pleadings, exhibits and the evidence and was sub-
mitted to the Court, and it appearing to the Court that two thirds and
more of all the proprietors of lots and lands in all that part of
the North Addition to the village of St. Marys, Ohio lying north of
Indiana Avenue in said village have filed their petitions in
writing in the Clerk of the Court of Vincennes, Indiana in and per
said Court praying the alteration of said plat as set forth in
said petition and that the applicants have given notice of the
pendancy and prayer of said petition by publication for thirty
days and more in St. Marys News and the St. Marys Graphic
two newspapers printed in said Anglaize County and
of general circulation therein, which notice set forth the part
of said North Addition to be altered, and the Court further find
that the plat of all that part of said North Addition above named
and specified be altered as prayed for in the petition herein. It is
therefore ordered and adjudged and decreed by the Court that the
plat of all that part of the North Addition to the village of St. Marys
Ohio lying north of Indiana Avenue in said village be so altered
and confirmed in a plat shown, published, marked &c. and hereby
made part of the record and entry. And it is hereby further ordered
that the clerk of the Court record the proceedings herein in the records of
this Court and that a copy of said records be made and certified by
said clerk and attested under the seal of said Court, and shall in
the petition herein within thirty (30) days from the rising of the
Court be deposited with the Recorder of said Anglaize County, which
said Recorder shall thereupon record the same. It is further ordered
that the petitioners herein pay the costs of this proceeding taxed
at \$ -- and execution is awarded.
