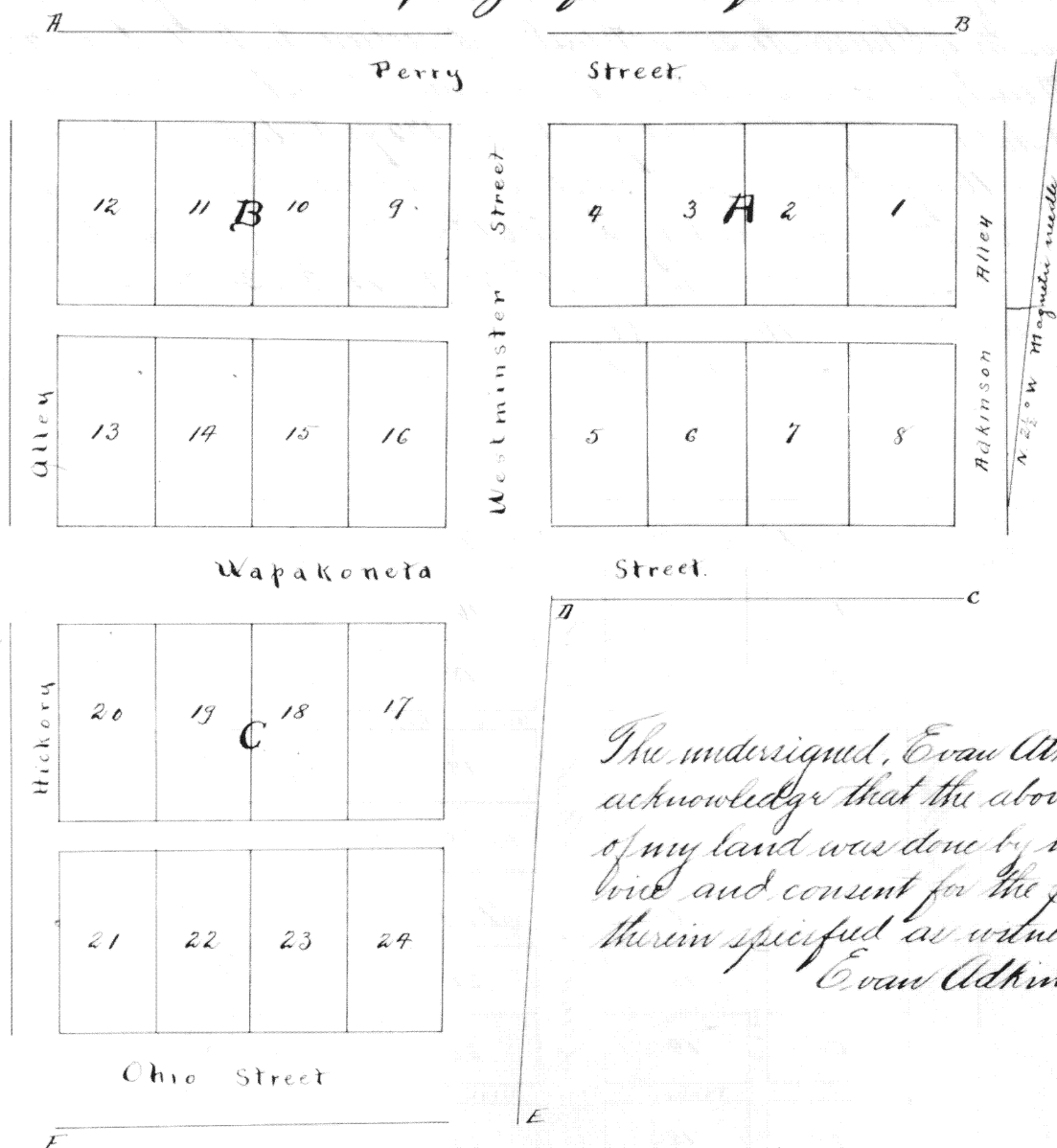


Waynesfield.

The New Town Plat of Waynesfield. first Plat.



The undersigned, Evan Atkinson, do acknowledge that the above survey of my land was done by my advice and consent for the purposes therein specified as witness my hand.

The new Town of Waynesfield, Adams County, Ohio, contained and laid out, A. on South West quarter of Section 17. B. on the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section 18. C. South half of South East quarter of Section 19, all of township five (5) south of range eight (8) east. The Wapakoneta & West Westminster Streets are 60 feet wide. The Perry & Ohio Streets are 41 1/2 feet wide. The alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide and all cross at right angles. The lots are 66 feet wide in front and 132 feet deep. Stakes are planted on the corners A, B, C, D, E & F. Commencing with letter A on the North west corner of said town lots, survey thence east to B, thence south to C, thence West to D (a stone is placed on the corner D), thence south to E. thence west to F, thence north as certified to A. being, all of which is certified to be correct, July 1st. 1848
