St. Johns Town. Old plat.

The town of St. Johns is laid out in Section number four (4) in Township 16
six (6) south of Range No. seven (7) east, and section No. thirty two (32). Range No.
seven (7) east, township five (5). Beginning at a stone at the north west corner
of lot No. 21. Lots are 66 feet front and 132 feet deep. Streets are 66 feet and
Alleys are 16½ feet wide and cross at right angles. Lots No. 1, 2, 9, 10, 17, 18,
19, 20, 25, 26, 27, 28 laid out by Daniel Bitter and Elizabeth his wife, and
Lots Nos. 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 24, 29, 30, 31, 32 laid out by John
Rogers and his wife Mary Rogers.
