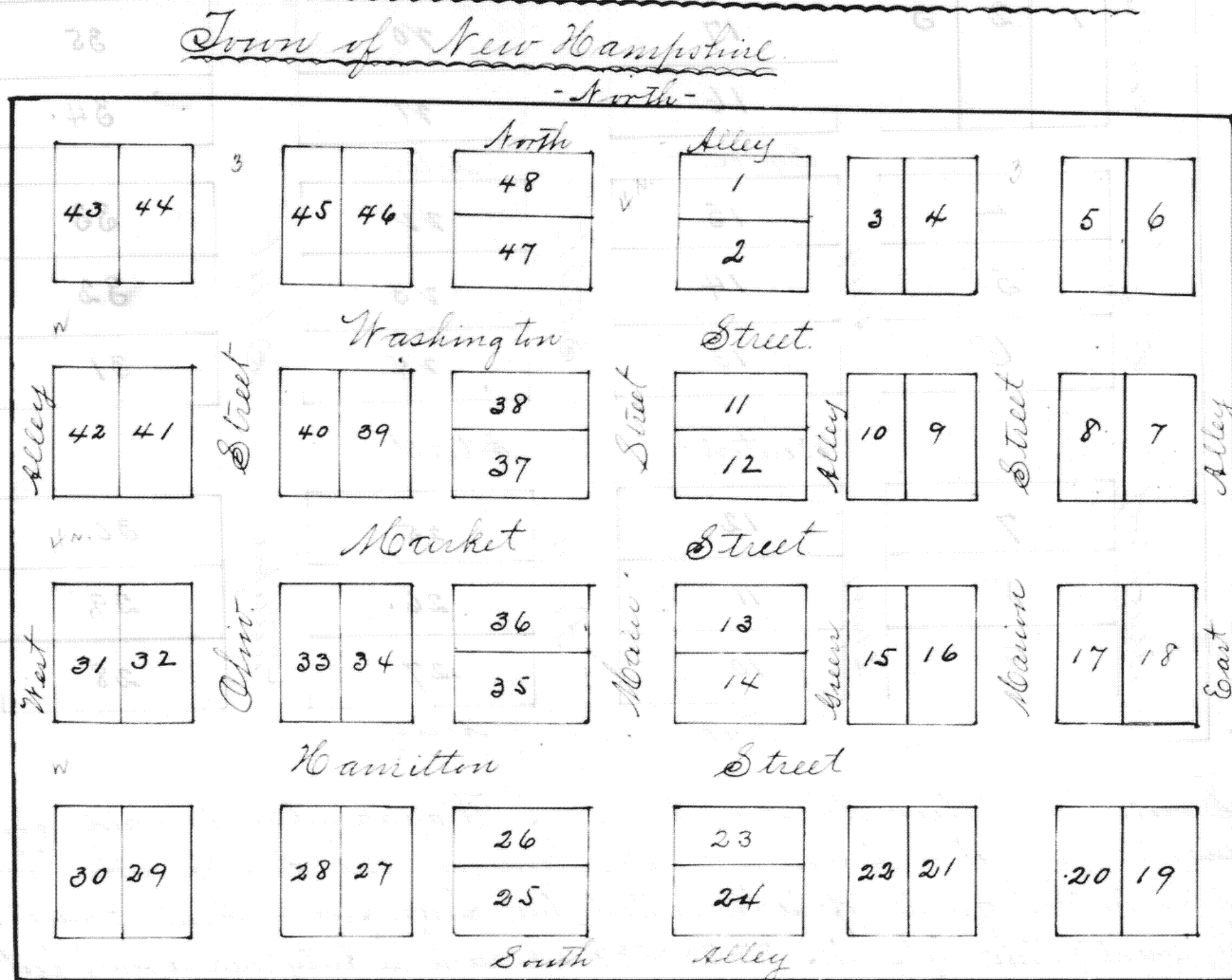


Entered for Record the 29th day of April A.D. 1835 and recorded the 20th day of July next following. John Ward Recorder A. Co. O.

New Hampshire is laid off on the north end of the West half of the North West quarter of Section Four Township six South of Range eight east. The lots are all four rods wide and eight rods long. The Streets and alleys all cross each other at right angles running with the cardinal points. Main and Market Streets are each four rods wide. Ohio and Main Streets are each three rods wide, and Washington and Hamilton Streets are each two rods wide. the Alleys are each one rod wide. a monument is placed at the South West corner of Lot no. 12.

I certify the above Plat and field notes to be correct as laid off by me this second day of - A.D. 1837. H. Davison Surveyor of Allen Co. Ohio.

Before me Hamilton Davison a Notary Public in and for said County, personally came John Kindle the proprietor of the within named town of New Hampshire and acknowledged the laying off of the same to be his act and deed for the uses and purposes therein set forth and desired that the same might be so recorded.
