South Addition to the town of Wapakoneta, is laid off by the undesignated proprietor. Adjoining said town on the South side, in the East half of the North West quarter of section thirty two, Town five (5) South Range six (6) East, in Allen County Ohio, Lots Nos. 37, 38 & 39 are each seventy and a half feet in front and one hundred and fifty feet deep, all the other lots are fifty feet in front and are one hundred and fifty feet deep. The Streets are sixty six feet wide and the Alleys sixteen and a half feet wide, and all cross each other at right angles. A Monument is placed at the North West corner of Lot No. one.
