

Fryburg. Old Plat of Fryburg.



Fryburg Survey July 1st. 1837. The town of Fryburg is laid off on the South part of the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section fifteen, Township six south, of Range six east in Allen County. Lots 15, 16 & 41 are each 64 feet wide and eight rods long; the lots bordering on the creek are of the dimensions noted on the plat in rods and links; the other lots are each eight rods long and four rods wide.

Van Buren, Sidney & Setters streets are each sixty feet wide. Schemel, Walnut, and Spring streets are each three rods wide; the alleys are each 12 feet wide and they all cross each other at right angles and run with the cardinal points. A monument is planted at the South east corner of Lot No. One.
