

Jamesville.



The town of Jamesville is laid out on a piece of ground embracing the south east corner of Section 36, Town 5 south, Range 6 east, and the south west corner of section 31, Town 5 South, range 7 east. Lots No 1, 23, 50 and 59 are each four rods wide and six rods long, all the others are each four rods wide and eight rods long. A monument at the south west corner of Lot No 1. The Streets and alleys all cross each other at right angles, running with the cardinal points.
