

# Uniopolis.

Scale:

8 rods to the inch.



The town of Uniopolis is laid off on the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Sec. 17 Town 5 South, Range 7 East. Lots Nos. 25, 26, 27, 28, 37, 38, 39, 40, 49 & 50 are each 5 rods wide and 8 rods long. All the other lots are each 4 rods front and 8 rods back. The streets and alleys cross each other at right angles. Ohio and Main streets are each 4 rods wide. Blackhoof, Oak and South are 3 rods wide, and West street is 43 feet wide. The alleys are each one rod wide. A monument is planted at the south west corner of Lot No. 10.

I certify the above plat and field notes of the Town of Uniopolis to be correct as laid off by me for John Hoffman, the proprietor Sept. 21, 1837.
