


Wapakoneta.
First North Addition



An addition to the town of Wapakoneta laid out by Peter Aughinbaugh, Jonathan K. Wilds, Joseph Barnett, Thomas B. Van Horn and Robert Skinner, laid off on the north side of Auglaize street, beginning at the south west corner of lot No. 5. No. 1 is 232 $\frac{1}{2}$ fronting on Auglaize street and 198 feet back at west end 154.44 at east end. Nos. 2, 3 & 4 are each 50 feet front and 154.44 back. Lot No. 5 is 166 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet front and 154.44 back. Lot No. 6 is 50 feet front and 154.44 back. Lot No. 7 is 100 feet front and 154.44 back. Lot No. 8 is 166 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet front and 154.44 back. Lot No. 9 is 116 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet front and 154.44 at west end and 110.72 back. Lot No. 10 is 166 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet front and 110.72 back at west end and 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet back. Lots run back at right angles with Auglaize street. Blackhoof street is 66 feet wide.

I certify the above to be a correct plat of an addition to the Town of Wapakoneta laid off by me. Surveyed Sept. 28. 1833.
