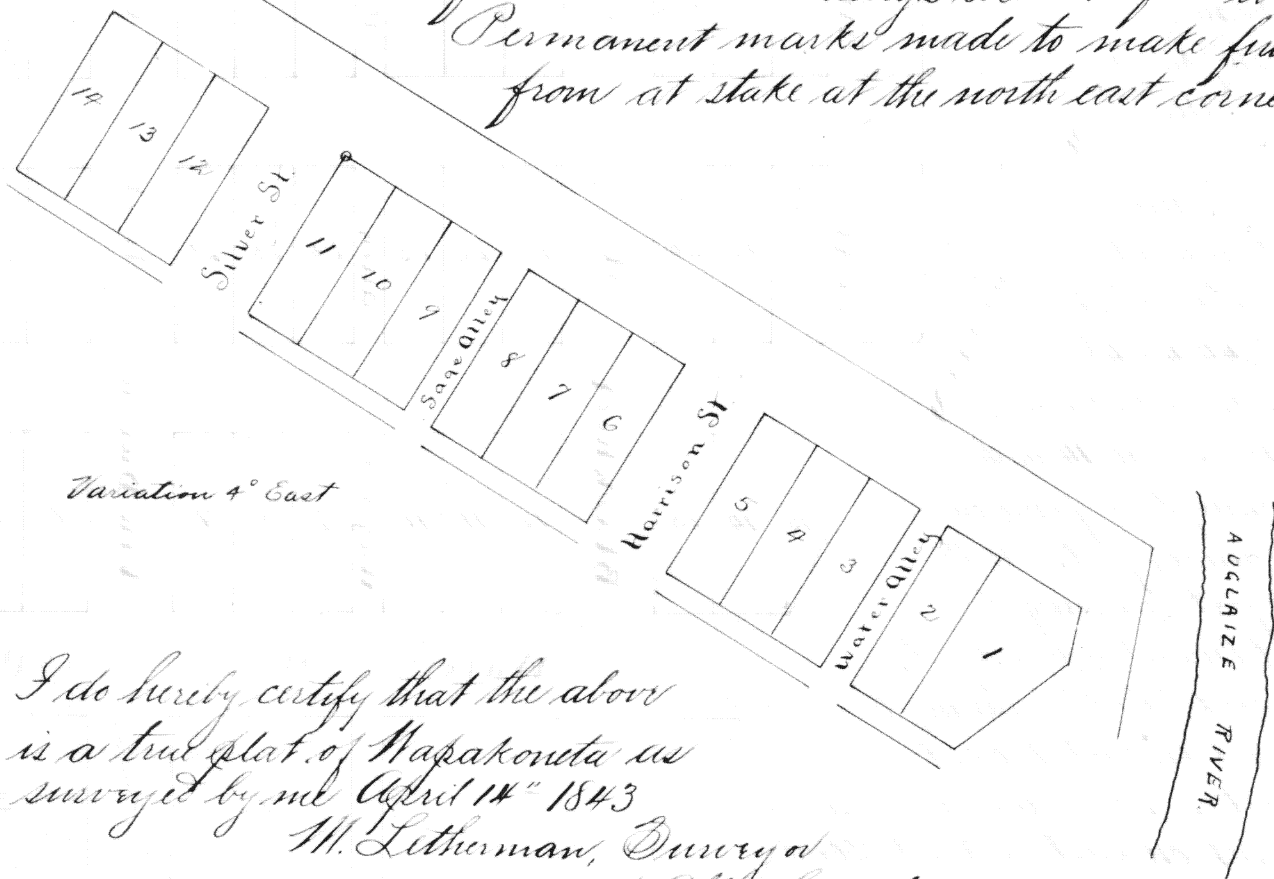


Wapakoneta.

North West Addition

North West Addition to Wapakoneta is laid out by John C. Bothe lying on the west side of the Amanda State Road, and on the north side of the Auglaize River in Section No. twenty nine, town five south of range six east. All lots running north 41° west. All lots are fifty feet in front and 150 feet back, except Lot No. 1 which is $82\frac{1}{2}$ feet front and 25 feet at back end and 150 feet back. All streets are 66 feet wide. All alleys are $16\frac{1}{2}$ feet wide.

Permanent marks made to make future surveys from at stake at the north east corner of Lot No. 11.
