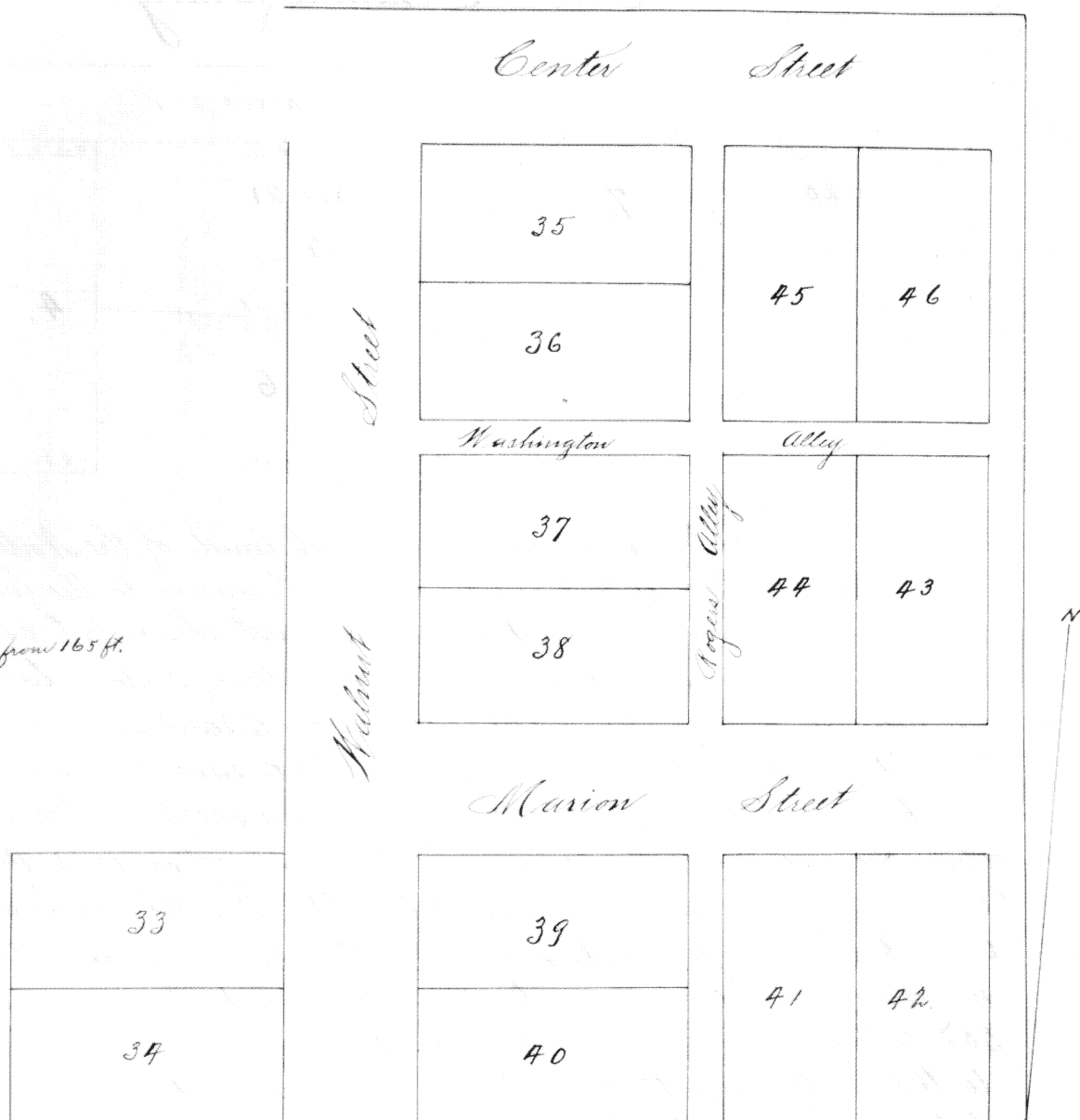


St. Johns. East Addition.

North and south streets are 2° 35' to the East and West Streets running 86°; it contains 14 lots: All lots are 66 feet in front and 132 feet back as numbered. All streets are 66 feet wide the alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide and run at right angles. Said lots are laid out by John Rogers.

All streets are 66 feet wide. The alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide and run at right angles. Said lots are laid out by John Rogers.
