This Addition is laid off south of the South Addition to the Town of Bremen in NE 1/4 of Section 15, T. 18. N. 4 E. and comprises lots 102, 107 to 140 with the Out Lots from No. 1 to 7.

South street was formerly made only 33 feet wide, the proprietors add 33 feet more making South Street 66 feet wide. The Piqua road or Main Street is 66 feet wide, so are all other streets. The alleys are all 16 1/2 feet wide (or 25 links). All lots are four rods wide (66 feet) and eight rods long (132 feet) except fractional lots which lines are named on the plat. Main street and all other streets north and south are 10° N. of Magnetic N., the alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide. All of which I believe to be correct to the best of my belief.
