This Addition comprises 68 lots of a regular shape with the width and length designated on the plat in chains and links, and 33 fractional lots around the boundaries; the width and length are also marked on the plat in chains and links, and is taken from a part of the West half of the South West quarter, Sec. 3, T. 6 S. R. 4 E. and the North west corner of the North West quarter Sec. 10 town and range aforesaid. The line on the south east corner crossing the lots is the section line between sections 3 & 10 making a strip 250 feet wide; the variation on the west and east boundary line is 4° and the whole survey is done on the same assumed variation. The course of all the streets running southward is $S 25^{\circ} E$ and of the streets running west is $N 25^{\circ} W$. The alley south of South Street parallel is one rod wide, all others 12 feet. All the Streets are 4 poles wide and cross at right angles corresponding with the Old plat of St. Marys. Lots 6, 7, 8, 9, 14, 16, 17 joint property of W. L. Helfenstine and J. W. Riley, all other the property of W. L. Helfenstine.

I believe the plat to be correct according to the survey made.
