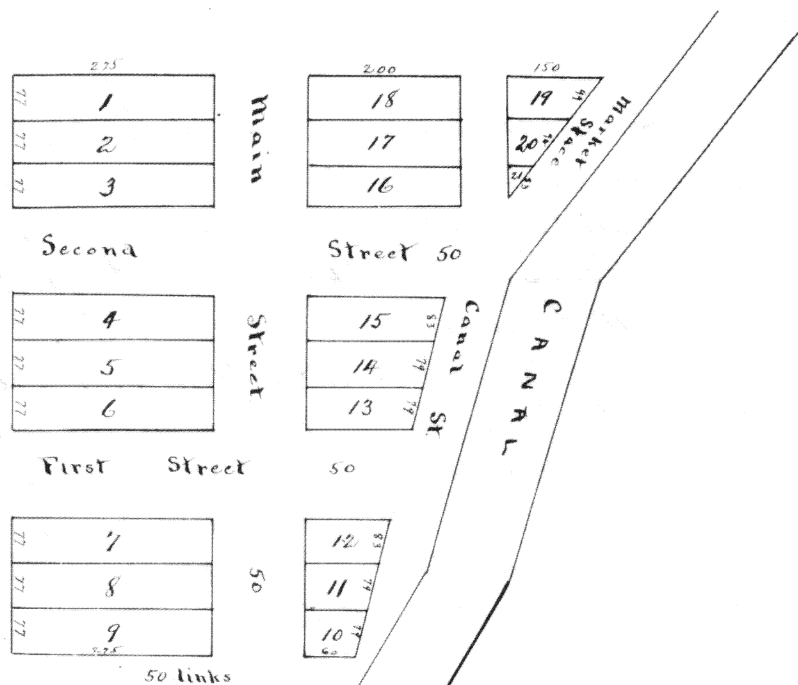


Mormannville.



Is situate in the North East corner of the South West quarter of Section eleven, T 1 S. R. 4 E. Lots No 1 to 9 are three hundred and eighty nine. Lots ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen are two hundred and seventy seven links or fifty feet by one hundred and thirty two feet. Lots ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen and all fractional, their dimensions and lines marked on the plat in links. The space called Canal Street is unbounded as the Canal is not yet marked out but it occupies all the vacant ground that may be left from the tier of lots on the canal. Main Street is fifty links or thirty three feet wide; the alley between Lots 18 and 19 is 18 links or 12 feet wide. First and Second street is 33 feet wide; the west alley is 25 links or 16 feet wide; the variation of the line running north is 4° 5 West; the line running E is 4° 22', consequently in making the town square it makes the east end of Lot 1, 80 links wide and Lot No 18, 83 links wide at the E end. A stone planted at the quarter section post and at the N E corner of Lot No 1. I certify the above to be correct to the best of my knowledge.
