

# St. Marys. - South Addition

The South Addition of St. Marys is laid out upon a part of the South half of the South West quarter of Sec. 3 and over part of the North half of the North West quarter of Sec. 10, T6S. R4E.

This part thereof comprises all lots No. from 38 to 71 inclusive and are described as follows:

All of the lots situated between Front and Main streets are one hundred links wide and one hundred and twenty five deep, except Lots 54 + 55 which are 151 links by 125 links. All lots between Wayne and Main streets are 100 links front by and 250 links deep, excepting Lots 50, 51, 52, 53 which are fronting on Market Street and are 125 by 151 links. Front and Houston streets are each 100 links wide. Wayne and Main streets are each 125 links wide. Market street is 100 feet or 152 links wide. The alleys between Main and Wayne streets are 12 feet wide, all others are 25 links wide. The magnetic variation at this time is  $4^{\circ} 10' E$ . and with the variation Front, Wayne and Main streets bear North  $25^{\circ} E$ . All other streets are at right angles. A stone is planted at the south east corner of Lot No 48, corner of Main and Market streets.

I do hereby certify the survey of said plat and description to be done correctly to the best of my ability and belief. May 4th AD 1839.
