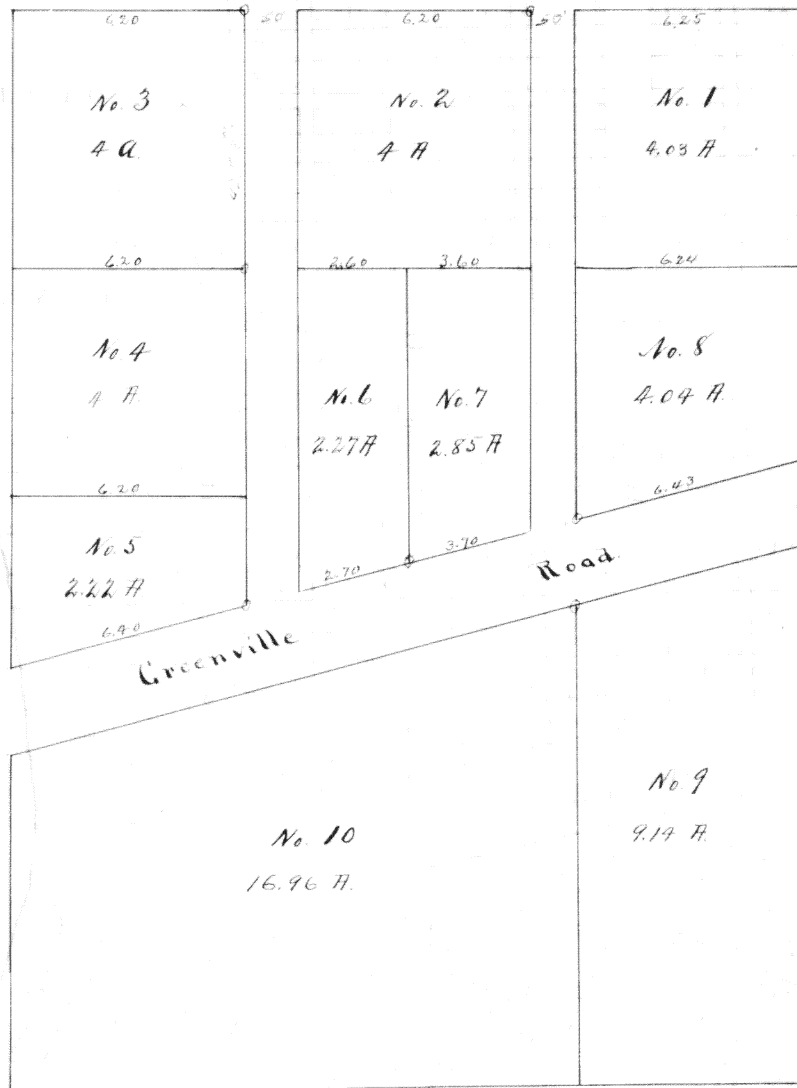


Out Lots at St. Marys.



These Out Lots from Number 1 to number 10 are laid out upon a lot or Share No. 7 of the Adm. Subdivision of the estate of Charles Murray, decd. Said lot being a part of the NW 1/4 of Section 10, Town 6 south, Range 4 east. The length and breadth of each lot is marked on the line thereof. The bearings of the diagonal lines between Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, & 9, 10 which is also the north line of the State Road from St. Marys to Greenville bears variation of the compass $3^{\circ}55'$ E.; the two lines running north and south are each 50 feet in width. Stones are planted at the north east corner of Lot No. 1, 2, 4 & 10, the north west corner of Lot No. 9, the south west corner of Lot No. 7 & 8 and the south east corner of Lots Nos 3, 5 & 6.
