

Bremen N. Add.



The North Addition to the town of Bremen, Mercer county, Ohio, is laid out on the North half of the South East quarter of Section ten (10), Township seven (7) south of range four (4) east of first principal meridian. This Addition contains 30 In Lots, 3 Out Lots and a lot for a public graveyard. There are five streets in this Addition, three of which, Main, Herman and Franklin bear $N 6^{\circ} 15' W$ and the other two, Pearl and Ash run at right angles thereto. Pearl, Ash and Main Streets are each 90 links wide. Franklin and Herman are each seventy five (75) links wide. The In Lots are each two chains $16\frac{1}{2}$ links long and one chain wide. The lines bounding the ends of the In Lots are all parallel to Pearl street. The Out Lots and Grave Yard lie on the West side of Herman Street. The Out Lots are designated in the above plat by Roman numbers; the distance of their boundary lines is marked on the plat. The Grave Yard contains one and nine hundredths acres. Out Lot 1 contains sixty eight hundredths ($\frac{68}{100}$) acres. Out Lot No. 2 contains eighty nine ($\frac{89}{100}$) hundredths acres. No. 3 contains $\frac{8}{100}$ acres. The Alleys are each twenty five links wide and run as designated on the plat. The alleys on the south side of this Addition is not intended to be made part of this Addition inasmuch as the land upon which it has been laid out does not all belong to B. F. Schroeder at whose instance the survey was made. A corner stone is planted at the north east corner of In Lot No. 19 and at the South east corner of In Lot No. 24. A corner stone is also planted at the south east corner of each of the Out Lots and Grave Yard. The line bounding the west side of the Graveyard and Out Lots bears $N 15^{\circ} E$. I certify the foregoing description and delineation of the North Addition of the town of Bremen to be correct this 23^d day of June 1845.
