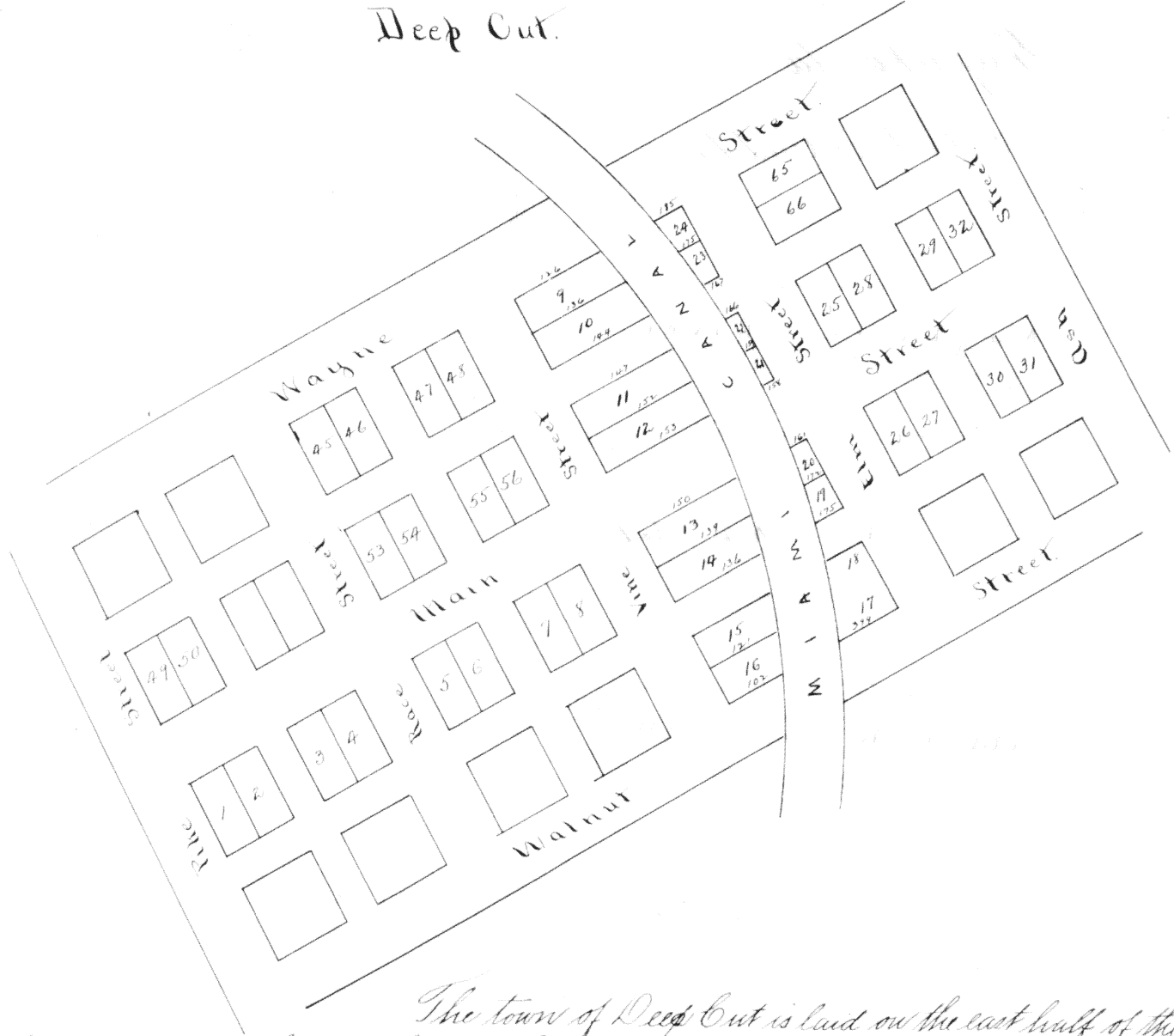


Deep Cut.



The town of Deep Cut is laid on the east half of the south west quarter, and the west half of the south east quarter of Section 25, Town 4 south, range 4 east of the first principal Meridian. It contains 32 In Lots all of which except those adjoining the canal are each 66 feet wide and 132 feet long. The lots on the Canal are the same width and the length of their sides in links is marked on the map now with small figures. Main Street is 66 feet wide and bears S. 60 W.: all other streets are each 54<sup>10</sup> feet wide and run parallel to or at right angles to Main Street, as designated on the map: the Alleys are all 16<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> feet wide. The lots and squares not numbered on the map are not intended to be made a part of the town plat. Corner stones at N.W. 4 and S.W. 16.

I certify the foregoing description and delineation to be correct this 13th day of October A.D. 1845.
