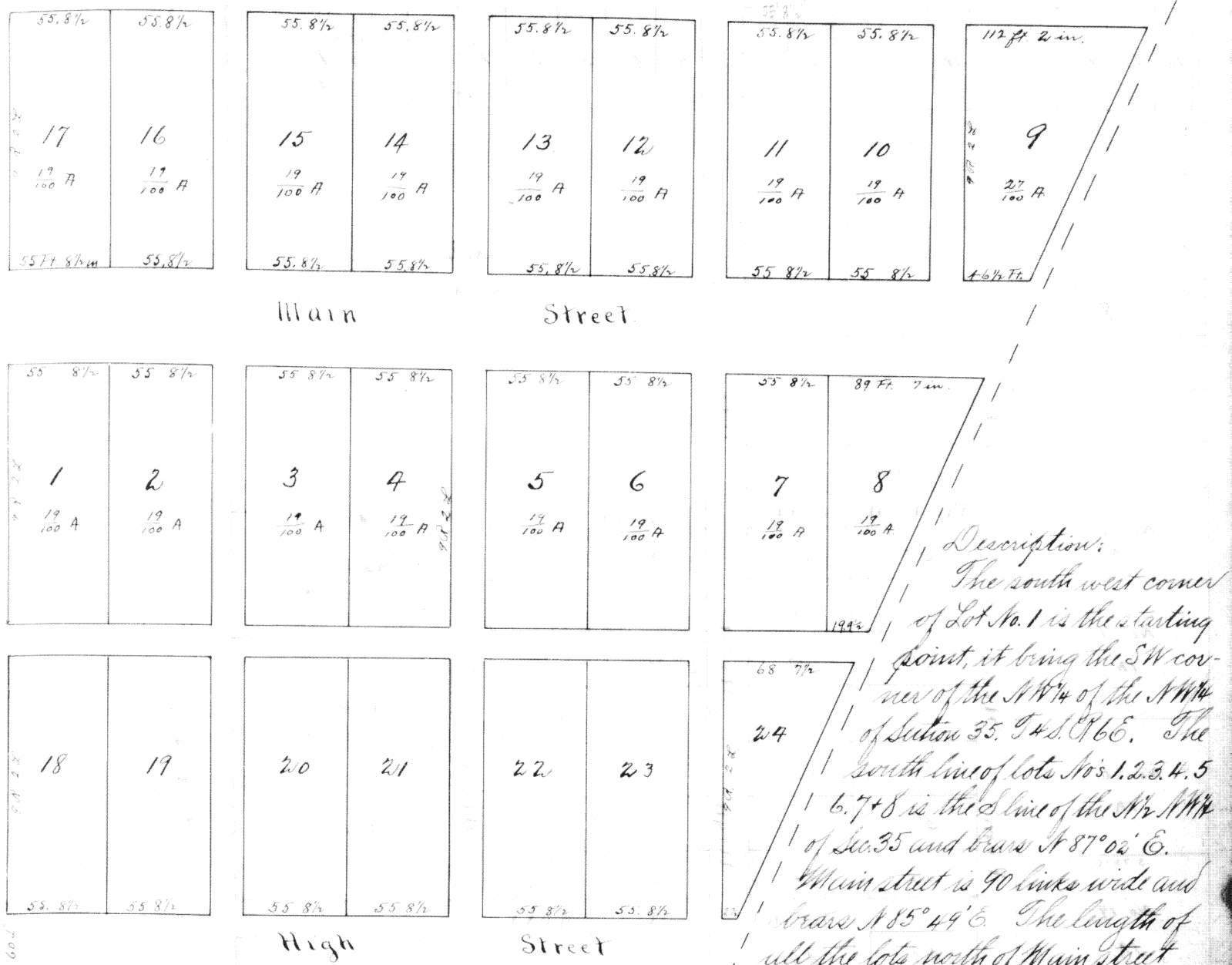


Plat of the Town of Cridersville, situated in the North West quarter of Section 35,
Town 4 south, Range 6 east. E. and Isaac Criders, proprietors.
Surveyed April 17th 1856 by Harrison Mattbee.



Description:

The south west corner of Lot No. 1 is the starting point, it being the SW corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 35, T. 4 S. R. 6 E. The south line of lots Nos 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8 is the S line of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 35 and bears N 87° 02' E. Main street is 90 links wide and bears N 85° 44' E. The length of all the lots north of Main Street is 9 rods and 2 links. The length of the W side of Lot No. 1 is 4 rods and 2 links. The lots in going E. increase in length, in consequence of Main street not being parallel with the south line of the lots. All the S. block of lots are 9 rods and 2 links long. All the lots except No. 8, 9 and 24 are 3 rods and 9 1/2 links wide. All the alleys are 20 links wide except the alley south of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 which is one rod wide. High street is 60 links wide. North line of Lot No. 9 is 6 rods and 20 links. S line of lot No. 9 is 2 rods and 20 links. Isaac Criders is the proprietor of Lots Nos 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 together with the alley N. of them and High street S. of them, and Ephraim Criders the proprietor of all the rest. I hereby certify that the above is a correct plat of the Town of Cridersville, as surveyed by me April 17th 1856.
