The town of Kossuth is laid off on the East half of the $N\frac{1}{2}$ and the West half of the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 25, Town ship 4 of range 4 east of first principal meridian. It contains forty two In/Lots and eight Out Lots. All the In/Lots except those adjoining the canal are each 66 feet wide and 132 feet long. The lots on the Canal are the same width and the length of their sides in links is marked on the map with red ink. Main Street is 66 feet wide and bears $S 60^{\circ} W$. All other streets are each 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. wide and run parallel to it at right angles to Main St. as designed on the map. The alleys are 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet wide. The Out Lots or Blocks contain each the size of two full In/Lots except No. 8 which contains an amount equal to 7 In/Lots. Corner Stones at $N\frac{1}{2}$ and $S\frac{1}{2}$. I certify the foregoing delineations and description to be correct. AD 1858. John B. Houston, Surveyor.
