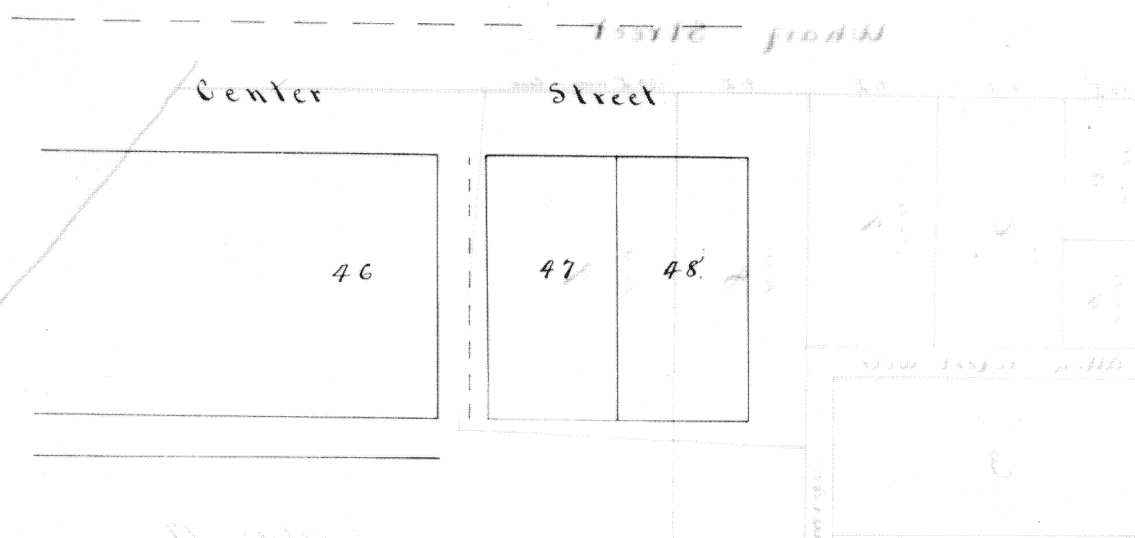


John Rogers' 2^d East Addition to St. Johns.



The accompanying plat represents the 2^d East Addition to the town of St. Johns, in the North West quarter of Section five, Town 6, Range 17E. Each lot is 66 feet front on Center Street and one hundred and thirty two feet in length. There is three feet added on the east side of Buena Vista alley.
